About

Visegrad+ Grants support projects which contribute to the democratization and transformation processes in selected countries of the

Western Balkans
(Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo*, North Macedonia, Montenegro, Serbia) and the

Eastern Partnership region
(Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine).

How does it work?

Come up with a project idea and involve partners from at least 3 Visegrad countries, and 1 entity from the EaP region or the Western Balkans countries at minimum.

Register in the MyVisegrad portal and submit your application.

Apply until February 1, June 1, or October 1.

Visegrad+ Grants Scheme



Who can apply?

Any legal entity from any country can apply for support if they fulfil the partnership criteria:

Conditions

- Projects implemented in the EaP or WBs region, and/or have a strong impact on local communities
- Maximum duration of project - 18 months
- Cover up to 100% of project budget - maximum 15% of overheads
- Address one of the objectives of Grant's seven focus areas
- Consultations up to 14 days before the application deadline.

Visegrad Mobility Programs



Visegrad Scholarship Program

Supports Master and post-Master students and researchers in all disciplines and in any language for up to two semesters at educational institutions in the V4.

Support of €3,000/semester for scholar + €1,500/semester for the host institution.

Deadline: 15 April

Visegrad Scholarship at the Open Society Archives

Supports scholars, artists or journalists who wish to conduct research at OSA, and whose current research projects are relevant to the research priorities .

Support of €2,700 /two months.

**Deadlines:
25 July and 15 November**

Research Grants at Historical Archives of the EU

Supports scholars interested in European integration with a unique research experience in the HAEU in Florence.

Support of €5,000

Deadline: 30 April
