
EUROPEAN FOOD FESTIVAL 2015



The European Food Festival, held on the occasion of the 40th anniversary of the EU-China diplomatic relations, officially opened last Thursday October 29th, in the presence of EU Delegation representatives, Huangpu District officials and EU member states Consuls.









The festival, located on the prestigious Bund promenade, offers a large range of European delicacies: Spanish tapas, Dutch cheese, Austrian chocolate, Irish beers, Czech mineral water, Greek tzatiski, French Boeuf Bourguignon, Italian pasta... to name a few. The event is composed of 32 booths (wooden chalets and pagoda tents) held by restaurants, food importers and wine and beverage distributors or producers.
