In addition to the race, Prague offers a variety of fun activities, making the event suitable for the whole family. After a sporting performance such as running a marathon each and every one deserves a cold beer. The Marathon race takes place in early June, which gives runners plenty of time to train after the winter. A significant part of the town and its charm is the legendary brewery Budweiser Budwar. Besides beer, the city is also known for its ice hockey team.
