INTERNATIONAL CHILDREN'S EXHIBITION OF FINE ARTS LIDICE 2010-2014

The exhibition presents the best winning works from 2010-2014 of one of the world's biggest and oldest exhibitions of children's art work, the International Children's Exhibition of Fine Arts Lidice. The International Children's Exhibition of Fine Arts Lidice (ICEFA Lidice) was established in 1967 to commemorate the child victims from the Czech village of Lidice murdered by German Nazis, as well as all other children who have died in wars. Although national initially, this exhibition became an international one in 1973 and since then it has become well known among children and teachers not only in our country but literally all over the world. In recent years, more than 25,000 very good works of art have been coming regularly by children not only from the Czech and Slovak Republics but also from other 60-70 countries, including such distant ones as China, India, Japan, Kenya, Malaysia, Philippines, Sri Lanka or Zimbabwe.
