



## Masaryk as a Phenomenon

The exhibition project of the National Museum has been prepared for the 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the death of professor and president Tomáš Garrigue Masaryk on 14<sup>th</sup> September 1937 and at the same time for the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of independent Czechoslovakia on 28<sup>th</sup> October 1918.

The exhibition combines classical display panels with projections and at the same time emphasizes the relationship of Tomáš Garrigue Masaryk to the country where it is going to be presented.

- Stay in the USA 1918, Pittsburgh, Washington
