CHANGES TO CHECK-IN OF SELECTED FLIGHTS FROM TERMINAL 1

We are building a more modern and comfortable airport for you to enjoy. Therefore, from March to August 2020, passengers of certain flights departing from Terminal 1 are checked-in at Terminal 2. We apologise for the temporary inconvenience caused and wish you a pleasant flight.

Is your flight operated by one of the airlines listed in the chart on the right? Please check. →



You ARE NOT affected by the change if:

1. You are departing from Terminal 1 and your airline is not on the list
2. You are departing from Terminal 1, your airline is on the list, but you have already checked-in online and travel with cabin baggage only
3. You are departing from Terminal 2



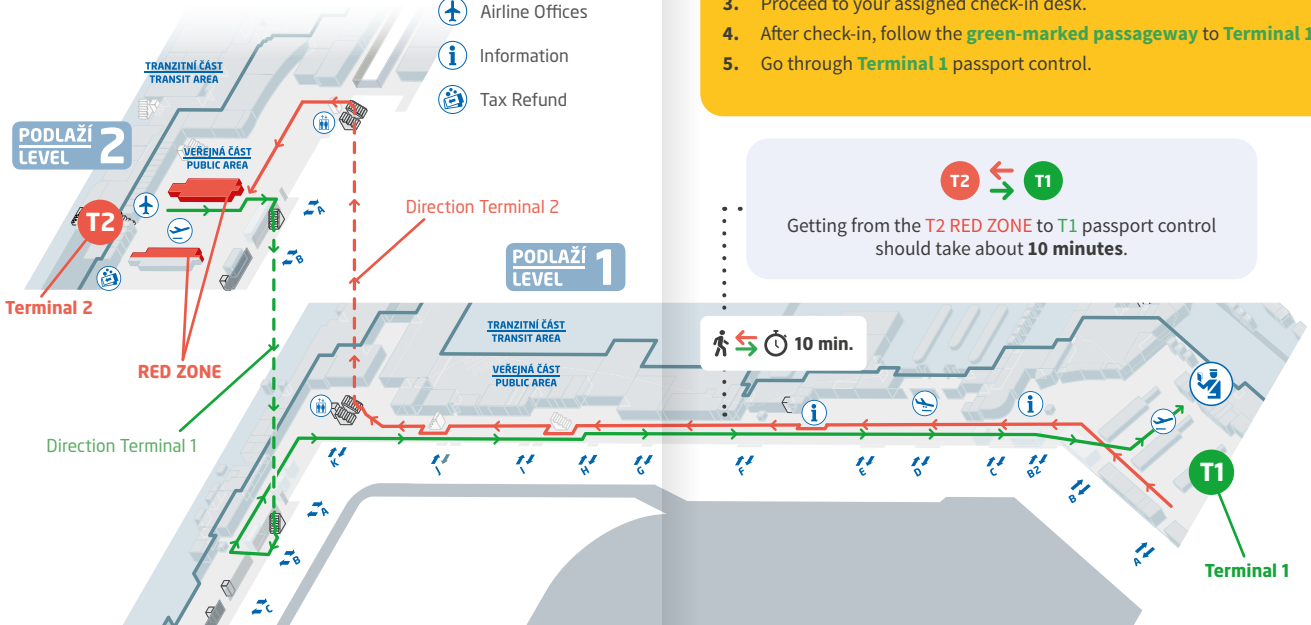
You ARE affected by the change if:

You are departing from Terminal 1, your airline is on the list, you are travelling with checked baggage and need a boarding pass.

In this case, your flight will be handled in Terminal 2, but your departure, passport control and security screening will take place in Terminal 1.

PASSAGEWAYS BETWEEN TERMINAL 1 AND TERMINAL 2

How to proceed?

- 1 A. Go straight to **Terminal 2**.
- 1 B. If you are already in **Terminal 1**, do not worry. Follow the **red-marked passageway** to **Terminal 2** Departure Hall. This should take about 10 minutes.
2. **Check the screen** or www.prg.aero to find out the check-in desk number assigned to your flight. Check-in desks are located in the **RED ZONE** area.
3. Proceed to your assigned check-in desk.
4. After check-in, follow the **green-marked passageway** to **Terminal 1**.
5. Go through **Terminal 1** passport control.



Getting from the **T2 RED ZONE** to **T1** passport control should take about **10 minutes**.



Terminal 1



We ask passengers to allow enough time before departure. **We recommend arriving at the airport at least three hours prior** to the scheduled departure of the flight.



Please note: all electronic devices, e-cigarettes, power banks and other lithium battery-powered devices **must be transported in cabin baggage only.**



You can have your tax refund form confirmed in the **RED ZONE**. Follow the **TAX REFUND** signs before checking in.
