Opening Message



Dear readers,

Allow me to present to you the second edition of the *Czech Diplomacy* publication. Unlike the last year, when I looked back at the achievements of my predecessors as well as on my own contribution, this publication takes stock of the work undertaken only by myself and my team throughout 2019.

There are many ways to characterize the year 2019. One of the key topics in international policy is multilateralism, a principle that has been gaining ground since 1945. Effective application of multilateralism is the crucial way to maintain a rules-based world order. In 2019, multilateralism underwent an endurance test. We saw global actors such as Brussels, Washington, Moscow or Beijing vehemently asserting their different views on the key questions of foreign policy, security and related issues. The level of disagreement on the future world order was obvious especially from the interaction between the United States and China.

In the European context, I was above all pleased by European Parliament elections. The voter turnout exceeded my expectations, and the result did not confirm the pessimistic predictions that the share of populist vote would be larger than ever before.

The year 2019 brought some great anniversaries, the most important one being the 70th anniversary of the North Atlantic Treaty Organisation combined with the 20th anniversary of our own NATO membership. Czech diplomacy never fails to stress the value of the alliance as there are too many political forces happy to challenge this fundamental pillar. The 15th anniversary of our EU membership was another important moment. Finally, 30 years have passed since the Velvet Revolution. Its legacy and ideals became the main building blocks of Czechoslovak and later Czech foreign policy in the 1990s.

The following chapters will give you a more detailed overview of the most important events and achievements of Czech foreign policy in 2019. The list is not and cannot be complete. It should serve as a source of basic facts to help you understand the main direction of the work undertaken by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs last year on the basis of the long-term foreign policy concept and the present Government's programme statement. These activities contributed both to the visibility of the Czech Republic and to the achievement of our priority goals, including in bilateral relations. Readers may judge for themselves how we have coped with this daunting task.

Direction of Czech Diplomacy in 2019

During 2019 we celebrated several important anniversaries. Where else but in Czernin Palace should we commemorate the moments when our history took a new turn? Here, at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Warsaw Pact was finally dissolved on 1 July 1991, a move which definitely helped Czechoslovakia and other countries of Central and Eastern Europe to free themselves of Soviet influence.

In 2019, Czech diplomacy supported several conferences on security issues. It is important to remember what the Czech Republic has learned and gained through its membership in the Alliance. It is important to realize that our security does not begin at the national border – on the contrary, our security is at stake whenever an ally comes under threat. Ability to adapt to new threats, with their increasingly complex and hybrid nature, is also crucial for our security. The Czech Republic is ready to accept its share of responsibility and fulfil the obligations arising from its Alliance membership -- not only in response to the the United States putting pressure on the allies to meet their respective commitments, but mainly for the sake of itself, its security and its allies.

In March 2019, the Czech Republic commemorated the 20th anniversary of its accession to NATO. Celebrations at Prague Castle and Czernin Palace were attended by prominent guests, including former US Secretary of State Madeleine Albright and former NATO Secretary General George Robertson.

In 2019, fifteen years passed since the Czech Republic's entry in the European Union. In the context of the anniversary celebrations, Czech diplomacy sought to define its vision of the future European Union, in other words: the vision of the Union we need. In the context of the Brexit and the results of European Parliament elections, Minister Tomáš Petříček called for *“an active and unbiased discussion on what the European Union truly represents, what it pursues, what it plans, and what it could or should be doing.”*

The last, but not least important, anniversary of 2019 was the 30th anniversary of the Velvet Revolution. On this occasion, Minister Tomáš Petříček awarded the Medal for Merit in Diplomacy to twelve personalities who have significantly

contributed to the post-revolutionary course of our foreign policy. The Minister confirmed our commitment to the legacy of November 1989: *“Our clear political, security, economic and civilisational anchoring in the free, developed and prosperous West is the most precious legacy of the post-revolution years.”*

Throughout the past year, Czech diplomacy sought to build on this legacy by strengthening bilateral relations with our key partners, promoting respect for human rights around the world, providing development, transformation and humanitarian assistance, participating in civilian and military operations, and engaging in various multilateral formats.



Effective Multi- lateralism

In 2019, the Czech Republic paid increased attention to the UN reform promoted by Secretary General António Guterres. It also focused on effective linking of bilateral and multilateral cooperation, both in its national policy and in the relevant EU and NATO policies.

During the opening week of the 74th session of the UN General Assembly, the Czech delegation, led by Prime Minister Andrej Babiš, attended the Climate Summit and the High-level Political Forum on Sustainable Development, where the Prime Minister gave a speech on partnership for sustainable development. The Czech Minister of Foreign Affairs participated in a meeting of the Alliance for Multilateralism held on the margins of the UN General Assembly. The Czech Republic shares the Alliance's ideas; at the meeting it expressed political support for issues such as the impact of the environment on security, freedom of information, cyber security and international humanitarian law.

In 2019, the Czech Republic played a responsible role in several international organizations. In May 2019, the Czech Republic successfully completed its presidency of the Executive Council of the Organisation for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW) in The Hague. In January, the Czech Republic began another three-year term as a member of the UN Human Rights Council (HRC), and in the same month, it also chaired the Human Dimension Committee (HDC) of the Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe (OSCE). The chairmanship of this committee enabled the Czech Republic to effectively link its work in the OSCE with the HRC priorities, and to increase its overall influence in this thematic area. Another major success was the election of the Czech Republic to the Executive Board of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) for the 2020–2022 period. On the 60th anniversary of the Antarctic Treaty, in July 2019, the Czech Republic hosted the XLII Antarctic Treaty Consultative Meeting (ATCM), the first ever Antarctic Treaty meeting of this importance to take place in Prague. Thanks to the host country's diplomacy, the meeting was concluded with the adoption of the Prague Declaration recalling the Treaty principles and confirming the commitment to respect them.

Another significant success was the re-election of Petr Válek, Director of the International Law Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, as Chairman of the Committee of Legal Advisers on Public International Law of the Council of Europe (CAHDI).

The Czech Republic also chaired several regional formats, namely the Visegrad Group or the Austerlitz format (Czech Republic, Slovakia and Austria). In both cases, the Czech Republic worked for closer coordination with the partners on EU issues.

Czech Diplomacy within the EU

In 2019, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs allocated CZK 37,240,000 for voluntary contributions provided by the Czech Republic to international organizations over and above the level of its mandatory contributions. The funds went into activities promoting security, human rights protection, and economic development. For the most part, they were used to support the work of the UN, NATO Trust Funds, OSCE, Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), International Labour Organization (ILO), Council of Europe, and the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA).

The year 2019 was a turbulent one for the European Union. A new EU leadership was nominated following European Parliament elections. The President-designate of the European Commission, Ursula von der Leyen, was confirmed by a thin majority in the European Parliament in July 2019. The new Commission did not receive parliamentary approval until the end of November. The new EU executive thus assumed its positions on 1 December 2019. The election of Czech Commissioner Věra Jourová as Vice-President of the Commission may be considered a clear success of Czech diplomacy.

Brexit hovered in the background of the EU election year 2019. The final form of the UK's departure from the EU was still unclear. The Czech Republic made preparations for Brexit without a deal: the Brexit Act regulating the post-Brexit rights of British nationals living in the Czech Republic entered into force in 2019. The Czech Republic also defined its priorities for negotiations on a future EU-UK agreement: trade, security cooperation and the rights of EU citizens in the UK.

New EU leaders took over the negotiations on the 2021-2027 Multiannual Financial Framework. In this context, the Czech Republic took the lead in a group of countries supporting the EU cohesion policy. The Friends of Cohesion Summit of 16 EU Member States took place in Prague in November 2019. The summit was concluded with the Prague Declaration building on the new EU Strategic Agenda adopted by the European Council on 20 June 2019. Both documents underline the need to strengthen cohesion in the EU, including, but not limited to, by strengthening the convergence of our economies in a sustainable way based on social inclusion.

In order to reduce emissions in accordance with the Paris Agreement, Czech diplomacy worked towards recognition of the nuclear energy applicability in national energy mixes, which was finally confirmed in the conclusions of the European Council in December.

Although the topic of migration was not discussed as intensely in 2019 as it was in the previous years, the effort to find a European solution continues. Therefore, in the course of 2019, Czech diplomacy also participated in the search for a different solution to illegal migration heading to Europe rather than compulsory redistribution quotas.

Czech diplomacy also played an important role in finding a compromise solution and reaching an agreement on the so-called Mobility Package which aims to improve working conditions for European drivers and increase the competitiveness of road freight transport.

Thanks to our diplomacy efforts, the issue of the European Union enlargement has remained among its priority themes, and it is also one of the long-term priorities of the Czech foreign policy. In 2019, Member States' political debates on the Northern Macedonia and Albania opening accession negotiations were at the forefront. Despite the active general efforts of Czech diplomacy to adopt a decision to begin accession negotiations, no consensus within the EU was found during the year.



Human Rights

The Czech Republic continued to be an active player in the area of human rights in 2019. Through its Permanent Mission in Geneva, it participated in the activities of the UN Human Rights Council (UN HRC), namely by supporting 51 resolutions, e.g. on the human rights situation in Myanmar, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Syria, Iran, Belarus, Yemen, the Philippines, women's rights, human rights in the digital age or the death penalty. The Czech Republic also joined 28 statements on the human rights situation in Venezuela, the Crimea and Saudi Arabia. In 2019, the Czech Republic presented its view in the adoption of the HRC resolution on the right to freedom of peaceful assembly.

The Czech Republic completed its historically first membership in the Executive Board of the United Nations Children's Fund (2017–2019), as its Vice-Chairman. In this capacity, it advocated coexistence of the stabilisation, humanitarian and development activities. Through the exhibition named "Flying Doctors", the Czech Republic presented its MEDEVAC health-humanitarian programme and also financially supported the UNICEF activities for women and children in Iraq and South Sudan.

As chairman of the OSCE Human Dimension Committee since January 2019, the Czech Republic has initiated discussions, in particular, on participation in public and political life, promoting tolerance and non-discrimination, freedom of expression and media freedom, elections, prevention of torture, prevention of violence against women and support of civil society and human rights defenders.

The Transition Promotion Programme serves also for promoting human rights. In this programme, a total of nearly CZK 80 million was spent in 2019 on approximately 80 projects of Czech NGOs and institutions implemented in cooperation with their partners in the target countries. The Transformation Cooperation Programme focused on countries where there is a certain prerequisite for the transferability of Czech experience and a tradition of mutual contacts exists: Armenia, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Georgia, Kosovo, Cuba, Moldova, Myanmar and Serbia. Special attention was paid to the democratic transformation of Ukraine, where CZK 20 million a year was allocated between 2019 and 2021, of which CZK 10 million was earmarked for development and CZK 10 million for transformation activities.

Our foreign policy efforts also include a stronger commitment to sustainable development as its global support significantly strengthens common security.

In 2019, the government allocated a total of CZK 856 million for bilateral development cooperation (DC), of which CZK 394 million for development projects in priority countries (Bosnia and Herzegovina, Ethiopia, Georgia, Cambodia, Moldova and Zambia), almost CZK 130 million for development scholarships, CZK 50 million for the new programme Czech Development Co-operation Guarantee Programme and CZK 282 million CZK for other programmes involving the Czech private and non-profit sectors. In 2019, a new development co-operation methodology was approved. It allows designing new projects with respect to the situation in the field and it

puts emphasis on the role of embassies in project planning and monitoring.

In addition, programmes for placing teachers and experts abroad, trilateral co-operation subsidy programmes and the development-economic partnership programme for the private sector were modified.

In spring 2019, the Czech-Moravian Guarantee and Development Bank announced the first call for the Czech Development Co-operation Guarantee Programme. Companies with investment plans may obtain a public guarantee for up to a half of the loan in the developing country as long as the project contains sustainable development benefits in the target country (e.g. job creation).

Czech foreign development co-operation received a very positive feedback from the OECD in 2019, mainly thanks to the adoption of the Czech Development Co-operation Strategy 2018 – 2030, regular independent evaluations of development programmes and projects, and the creation of several new instruments. The Czech Republic also complies with the OECD recommendations adopted in 2019. Namely, the interconnection of humanitarian, development and peacekeeping activities as well as the introduction of measures preventing sexual abuse and harassment in development cooperation. In this regard, the Czech Republic has taken concrete steps, it has, for instance, agreed on the basic principles of conduct with Czech development and humanitarian organizations.

In 2019, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs supported a total of 54 humanitarian projects in 28 countries worldwide from the humanitarian aid budget, with a total value of CZK 247 million. In accordance with the priority areas of humanitarian aid, much of the humanitarian budget (80%) was donated by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for the needs of forcibly displaced people due to ongoing conflicts and instability in Afghanistan, Iraq, Yemen, South Sudan, Sahel, Syria, Ukraine as well as the growing crisis in Venezuela.

CZK 50 million was allocated for health care and basic needs of internally displaced Syrians and Syrian refugees in Lebanon and Jordan. The remaining 20% of the humanitarian budget was spent on immediate relief and disaster recovery, such as the drought in Ethiopia and Zambia, floods and hurricanes in the Philippines, Indonesia or Mozambique, and fire disaster recovery in Greece.

In addition, in August 2019, the government approved the continuance of the National Museum's programme for the restoration of the Syrian cultural heritage for the years 2020–2021, and allocated CZK 100 million.

In the provision of humanitarian aid, the MFA cooperates with Czech and local NGOs, United Nations agencies such as the United Nations Children's Fund, United Nations World Food Programme, Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees and the International Committee of the Red Cross.

The long-term priority of Czech humanitarian activities is to protect women and children from violence, especially by enabling them access to and participation in education and earning their livelihood. In 2019, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs supported a number of projects aimed at protecting women and children by donating more than CZK 50 million from the humanitarian budget.

Every year, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs financially and organizationally supports projects for the presentation of the Czech business sector abroad (the so-called PROPEDs – Economic Diplomacy Projects) and it was no different in 2019. In 2019, the Czech embassies implemented 288 projects worth more than CZK 48 million. In terms of sectoral focus, most projects covered agriculture and food industry (64), tourism (36) and defence (29).

In 2019, the new economic diplomacy instrument PROPEA was launched to support economic activities abroad. The pilot countries are Mongolia, Morocco and Japan. Its main objective is to strengthen the capacities of the Czech Republic to support a more sustainable presence of Czech companies on foreign markets and to reduce risks. In 2019, the network of export specialists working at regional chambers of commerce was expanded. In 2019, chambers from the Pardubice, South Moravian, Moravian-Silesian, Olomouc, Zlín, Pilsen and South Bohemian regions were involved. The regional export specialists, inter alia, participated in organizing regional seminars and several projects of economic diplomacy. The process of moving the representation of CzechTrade and CzechTourism to embassies was supported by agreements between the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Industry and Trade and the Ministry for Regional Development. By the end of 2019, 43 representations had been moved, i. e. 52% of the total number.

Economic Diplomacy



Security of the Czech Republic

The most important instrument for ensuring the security of the Czech Republic is the NATO collective defence system based on the mutual defence commitment. At the December meeting of NATO's top officials in London, the Alliance presented itself as a successfully transforming organization, particularly in the areas of defence burden-sharing, collective defence and preparedness for present and future challenges. In London, Member States officially opened a debate on the future of NATO. Its aim should be deepening of the Alliance political dimension.

NATO

NATO currently faces several challenges, in particular, the expiry of the Intermediate-Range Nuclear Forces Treaty (INF) and the fight against terrorism, particularly in the Middle East and the Sahel. In addition, the Alliance must deal with its modernization, enhancement of the military adaptation capability, functional inspection of the headquarters, expanding its space presence, and a new plan for innovative and disruptive technologies. Last but not least, the Alliance also evaluated the challenges and opportunities presented by China and the growth of its influence in the world. NATO and EU cooperation in the field of military mobility and defence against hybrid and cyber threats also continued to strengthen.

CSDP

Under the Common Security and Defence Policy (CSDP) and in line with the EU Global Strategy, the European Union continued to strengthen its defence capabilities and sought to deepen its cooperation with NATO as the main guarantor of Europe's territorial defence also in 2019.

In the framework of the Permanent Structured Cooperation (PESCO), the Czech Republic was concerned with a protracted discussion on the issue of third countries' involvement in PESCO joint projects and the efforts of some countries to significantly reduce this involvement. The topic discussed in 2019 was coherence of EU defence initiatives. This long-term process should result in a coherent system which would fully link the existing defence initiatives, in particular PESCO, Coordinated Annual Review on Defence (CARD) and the European Defence Fund (EDF) and ensure their complementarity with NATO.



In the civilian field of the Common Security and Defence Policy (CSDP), the process of its strengthening, which was initiated in 2018 with the adoption of the Civilian CSDP Compact or the Civil Capability Development Plan, continued. The European Centre of Excellence for Civilian Crisis Management, which Germany is seeking to establish, should also contribute to the effective implementation of the Civilian CSDP Compact. The Czech Republic supported this initiative in 2019.

OSCE

The Czech Republic also played an important role as the presiding country of the OSCE Forum for Security Co-operation (FSC) from September to December 2019. A specific feature of this presidency was the management of negotiations between the OSCE participating States on declarations and decisions of the OSCE Ministerial Council.

The Czech Republic organized security dialogues focused on political-military cooperation of the V4 countries, OSCE Code of Conduct, the role of women in the armed forces, the role of donors in SALW destruction projects, implementation and modernization of the Vienna document as well as SALW and conventional ammunition issues.

The year 2019 marked three significant anniversaries: 20th anniversary of the Czech Republic's accession to NATO, 15th anniversary of its accession to the EU, and 30th anniversary of the fall of the Iron Curtain (Velvet Revolution). Conferences, discussions with important participants, photo exhibitions, films and concerts were prepared. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs cooperated with Slovak partners in these events.

The public debate on Czech foreign policy in the context of the Velvet Revolution called the Afternoon with the Czech Diplomacy received a very positive response. The debate featured witnesses of the changes at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs after 1989 while current diplomats and other experts discussed the key foreign policy issues. Additionally, exhibitions on the Velvet Revolution, the anniversary of the Czech Republic's accession to NATO, digital exhibition Havel In A Nutshell (in cooperation with the Václav Havel Library) and the exhibition November 1989 in documents of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs were held to accompany this event.

One of the very successful and widely publicized events was the 80th anniversary of Winton's undertaking to rescue Jewish children in 1939. The event was organized jointly by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the British Embassy. On this occasion, Minister Tomáš Petříček awarded the representatives of those who organized the rescue children transports and the British families who fostered the children.

In 2019, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs also participated in the campaign #WeAreNATO promoting our membership in the North Atlantic Alliance. Fourteen projects related to Czech foreign policy priorities, including NATO Days in Ostrava, Prague European Summit and the One World film festival in Brussels were supported through grants. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs contributed to seven projects to support compatriot communities abroad.

In August 2019, the government updated a concept of a uniform presentation of the Czech Republic abroad, and in the autumn, it resumed the activities of the Interdepartmental Commission, where the Ministry of Foreign Affairs acts as a coordinator.



Czech Centres

In 2019, on the 10-year anniversary of the foundation of the Czech-Polish Forum, twelve Czech-Polish cooperation projects were supported as part of its subsidy programme.

Since 2012, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs with the Junior Diplomat Initiative (University of Economics in Prague) have been organizing the Diplomatic Salons. This tradition continued in 2019 with the salon on the role of the Czech Republic in NATO and the second one on 15 years in the EU.

In cooperation with the Czech Olympic Committee, a second conference on sports diplomacy was held in December, on the possibilities of strengthening the role of sport in presenting the Czech Republic abroad.

In 2019, Czech Centres prepared a number of projects of various genres in many different countries. Within its foreign network, it organized more than 2000 events.

At the beginning of 2019, the Czech Centre in Rome was reopened and in November, the Czech House in Bratislava, where the Czech Centre was moved, opened.

This year's central theme was the anniversary of 30 years of freedom. In cooperation with Dana Kyndrová, an exhibition of documentary photographs was prepared and presented in various countries of the world. The partnership with the National Museum resulted in a multimedia exhibition summarizing the events of the Velvet Revolution, and in cooperation with the Czech News Agency, a presentation of photographs from its archives, designed for exhibitions abroad, was staged.

At home, the Czech Centres, jointly with the cultural institutes of five Central European countries, implemented a project commemorating the anniversary of the fall of the Iron Curtain, which was presented at Národní třída during the celebrations of the 30th anniversary of the Velvet Revolution. A project called Freedom – a View of the Young Generation, intended for young audiences, was created with the involvement of art school students. In 2019, there were also exhibitions devoted to the 100th anniversary of Czechoslovak design, commemoration of important milestones in our history, Czech toys, the history of Czech comics and illustrations of children's books, a presentation of projects celebrating the success of Czech science and innovation called Czech Innovation Expo and a project examining the notion of the Czech Republic "brand" called CzechImage. The Susanna Roth 2019 Translators Competition took place as well as the 8th Czech That Film Festival, presenting contemporary Czech cinematography, which was organized in 22 cities across the USA and Canada. As part of the Shared Cities project, the exhibition named Iconic Ruins?, dedicated to the brutalist architecture of the V4 countries, was presented.

Compatriot Affairs

About two million people living outside the Czech Republic are of Czech origin. Many of them come from families who left their homeland several generations ago, but this number also includes young Czechs who work abroad.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs appreciates the good relationship of foreign Czechs with their homeland and strives to keep a dialogue with them through compatriot organizations or associations abroad. Annually, it supports nearly 300 of them in more than 50 countries worldwide with donations totalling CZK 21 million. Meanwhile, the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports supports teacher placement to compatriot communities, providing courses on Czech language teaching methodology, scholarships, and organizing a four-week Czech language course in the Czech Republic.

The main compatriot topics discussed in 2019 were the Romanian Banat, Brexit, compatriots in Ukraine and Venezuela, vote by correspondence, the Amendment to the Czech Citizenship Act, legal and practical anchoring of minorities abroad, support of the Czech education and the Czech Republic's return policy.

The Interministerial Committee for Czechs Living Abroad continues its activities, and, in cooperation with the partner ministries, it manages a web interface [Useful Information for Czechs Living Abroad](#). The Ministry of Foreign Affairs also cooperates on a long-term basis with Radio Prague International (formerly Radio Prague) and its [portal for compatriots](#).

In 2019, the MFA's Special Envoy for Czechs Living Abroad Jiří Krátký attended a series of meetings at home and abroad, where he spoke with the representatives of expatriates and expatriate associations. In addition to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Czech Senate Standing Committee for Czechs Living Abroad is mapping expatriate issues in the form of round tables or conferences. The last round table, entitled The Role and Place of Foreign Czechs in Bilateral Relations, was held in cooperation with the Academy of Sciences of the Czech Republic on 7 October 2019.

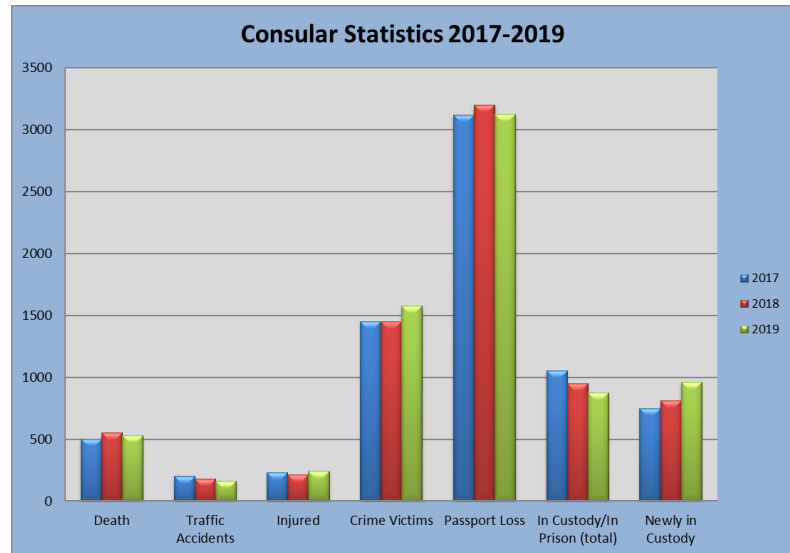

Citizen Service

The number of Czechs travelling abroad, often to exotic destinations, is constantly increasing. Foreign trips are sometimes associated with various risks and complications. The comparison of consular statistics for the years 2017–2019 shows which cases of consular assistance the Czech diplomatic missions had to deal with and how the monitored items evolved over the years.



Consular Affairs

In addition to Czech embassies, honorary consular officers, prominent personalities operating in different regions who perform their activities free of charge for the benefit of the Czech Republic, are often involved in helping Czech citizens in need.

In June 2019, the third worldwide meeting of Czech honorary consular officers took place in Prague (the first was in 2008, the second in 2013). The aim of the meeting was to express gratitude to honorary consuls for their activities performed for the Czech Republic and to broaden their professional knowledge necessary for carrying out the work of honorary consul as well as general knowledge of the Czech Republic. The meeting was attended by 170 honorary consular officers out of a total of 216 (status 6/2019).

The programme included a professional section focusing on all agendas of honorary consulates, and presentations complemented with one-day business and economic-themed excursions held across the Czech Republic. In addition to economic diplomacy, great attention was paid to the activities of honorary consuls in the field of public diplomacy, i.e. the presentation of the Czech Republic's good name in the world.

The mutual exchange of knowledge and experience of the work as Honorary Consul on a global scale was important and very welcome. The programme included a meeting of honorary consuls with important representatives of the Czech Republic.

Czech embassies received a record 815,000 visa applications in 2019, which represents an increase of 12.9% compared to 2018. 742,000 applications were processed for short-term Schengen visas, of which almost 470,000 were for tourist trips. There were also 24,490 applications for long-term visas and 48,430 applications for long-term or permanent residence permits lodged with the embassies.

The government's economic migration programmes were the ongoing topic of the visa agenda, including the Key and Scientific Staff Programme, Highly Qualified Worker Programme and the Qualified Worker Programme, which allow the acceptance and processing of employee (sometimes blue) card applications in an accelerated mode. All third countries are included in the Key and Scientific Staff Programme and the Highly Qualified Worker Programme (for some countries the government has set a maximum annual quota for applications). The Qualified Worker Programme, on the other hand, is implemented only in certain third countries, also through annual quotas. In 2019, the programme was extended to Belarus, Montenegro, India, Kazakhstan and Moldova, thus joining the existing target countries of labour migration: the Philippines, Mongolia, Serbia and Ukraine, where in 2019, there was a significant increase in the annual quota of applications received to 40,000.

In 2019, the so-called STUDENT Scheme continued, allowing simplified applications for long-term residency to university students in bachelor, master or doctoral study programmes.



Diplomatic Relations of the Czech Republic

At the end of 2019, the Czech Republic maintained diplomatic relations with **197** countries around the world. Most of these relations had been established already with the former Czechoslovakia.

Diplomatic Missions Abroad

The interests of the Czech Republic abroad are promoted by diplomatic missions of the Czech Republic abroad – embassies ([Annex 2](#)), permanent missions and delegations ([Annex 3](#)), consulates general ([Annex 4](#)), consular offices ([Annex 5](#)), other missions ([Annex 6](#)) and Czech Centres ([Annex 8](#)). In 2019, the Czech Republic opened a new Embassy in Bamako (Mali) and two Consulates General in Milan (Italy) and Manchester (UK). These official representations of the state are complemented by the Integrated Foreign Network of the Ministry of Industry and Trade, the CzechTourism Agency, as well as honorary consulates and honorary consulates general. These have similar functions as career consulates, however, they are headed by honorary consular officials who do not have diplomatic status and are not MFA employees ([Annex 7](#)).

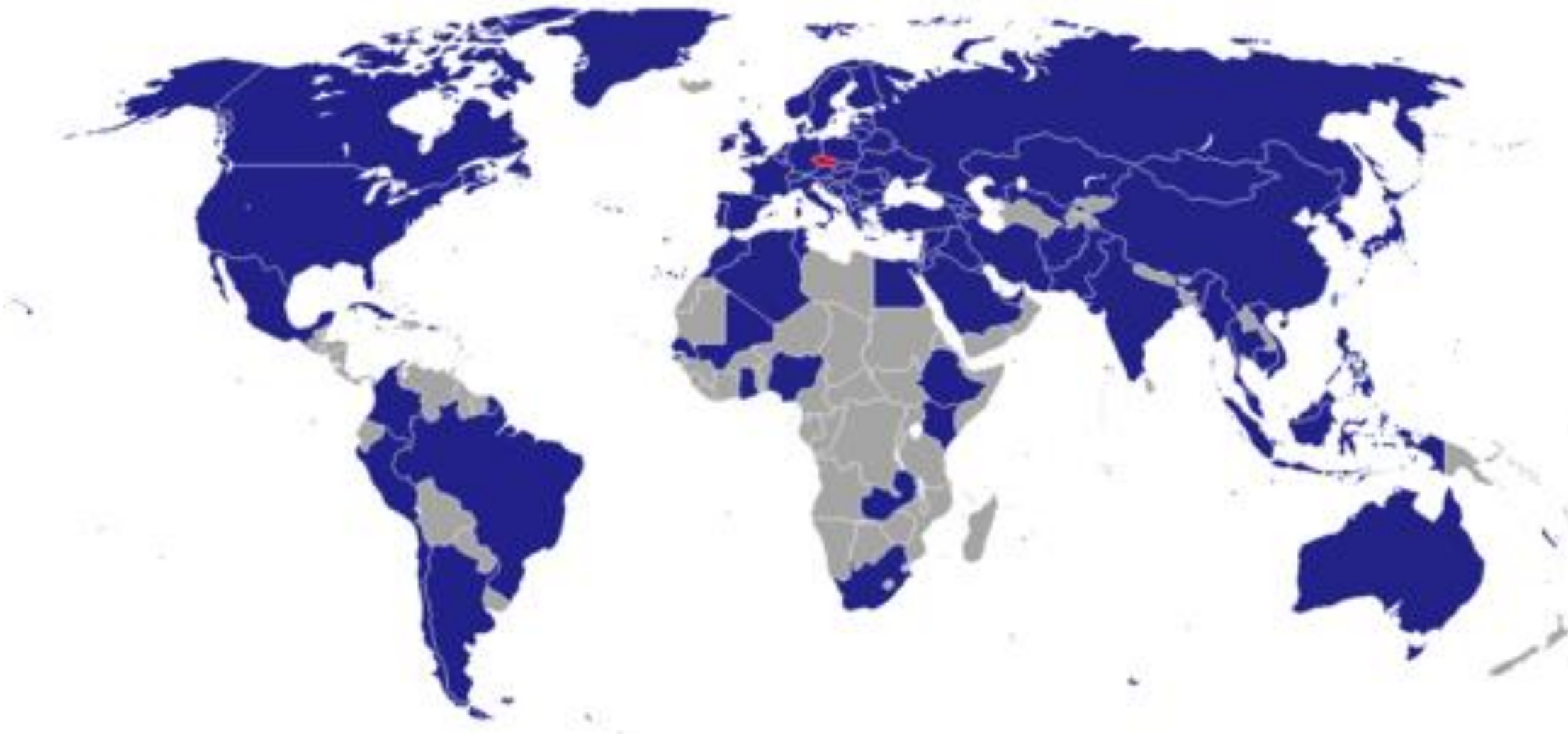

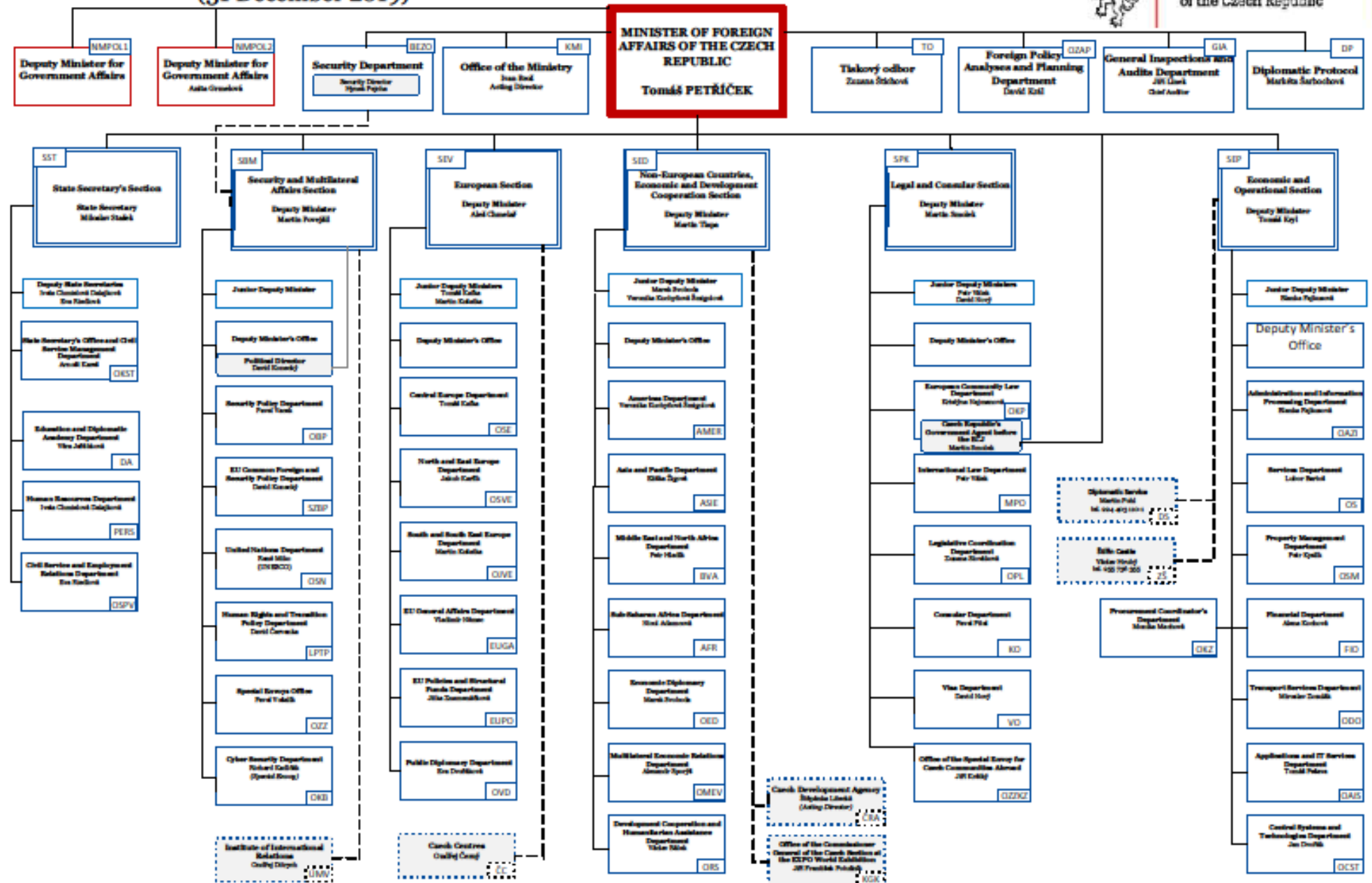

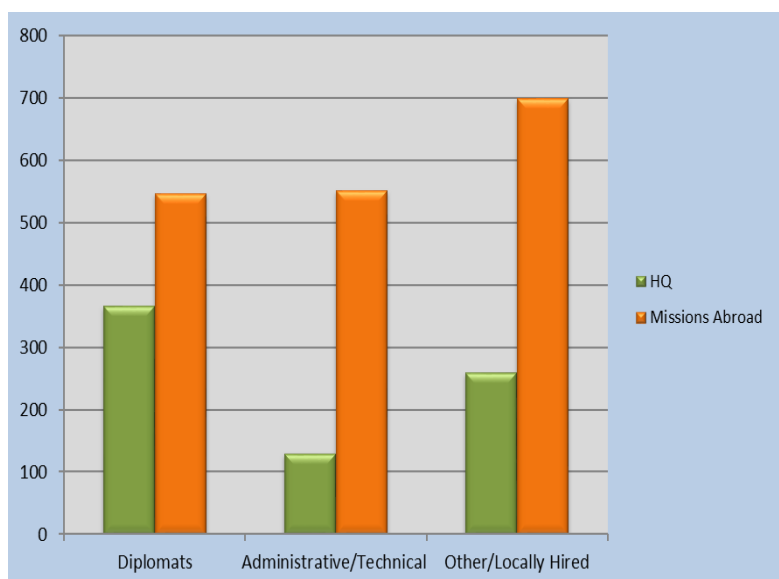
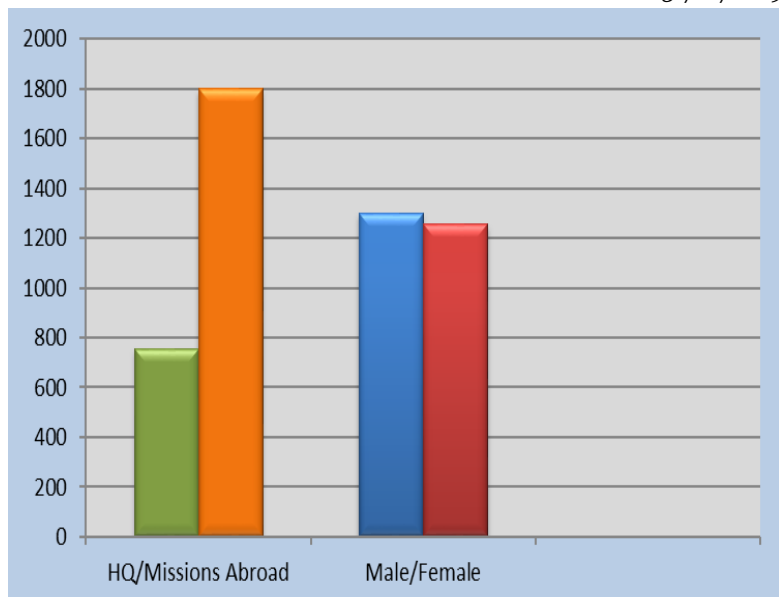
Ministry in Figures

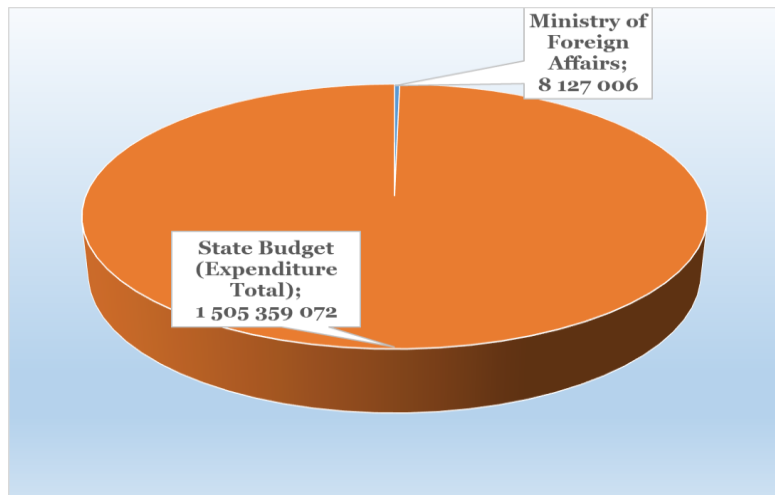

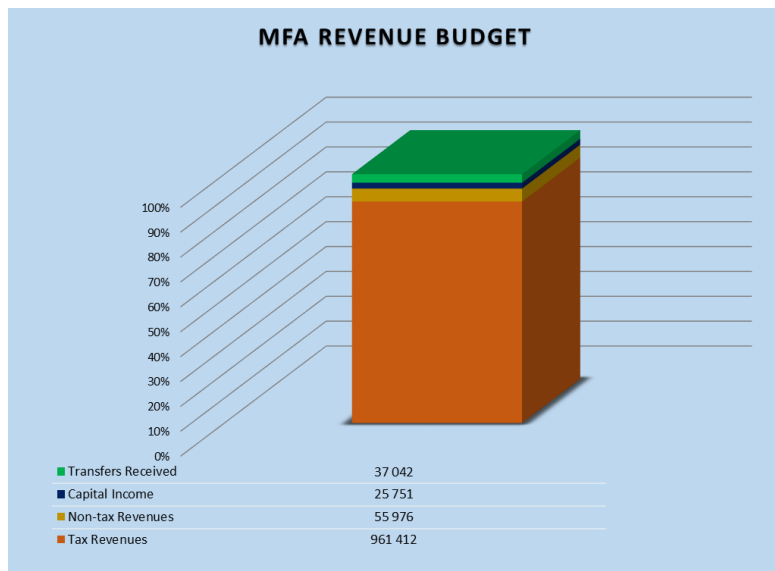

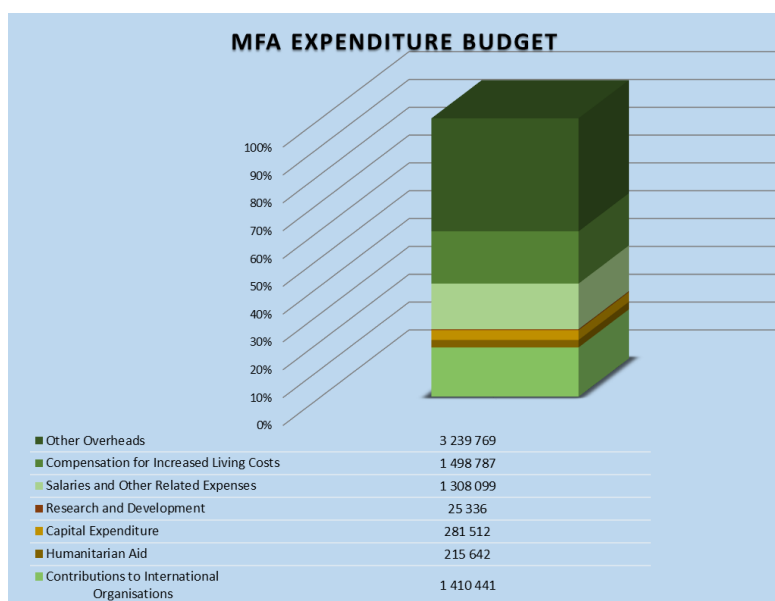
State Budget Allocation to the MFA

Expenditure (thsd. CZK)



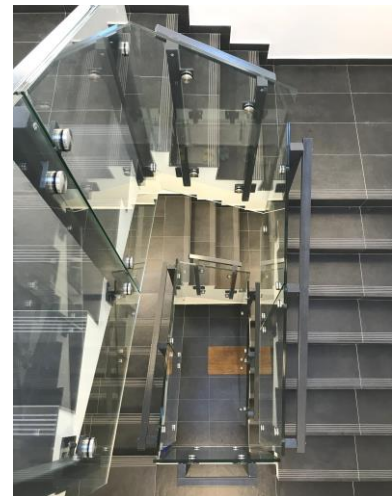

MFA Property

The main investment project of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 2019 was the completion of the Trauttmannsdorf Palace reconstruction. This created a fully-fledged administrative building which also includes exhibition space and conference facilities. The reconstruction began in 2015. By the end of 2019, some MFA departments moved to the new premises.

Another investment project, although not as visible but equally important in terms of eliminating health risks and improving the working environment of the employees, is the replacement of lead water pipework in the building of the Czernin Palace and a reconstruction of sanitary facilities. Due to the lack of storage space for archive materials under the care of the MFA Archive, the reconstruction of the warehouse building in Prague–Ruzyně has begun.

The largest investment project abroad is the reconstruction of the building of the Permanent Mission to the UN in New York. The preparations have been underway since 2010. Over the time, the initial project to revitalize the building gradually expanded to include complete renovation, change of use, and construction of a rooftop addition.

The second largest project abroad is the construction of the Czech Embassy in Canberra. The design phase started as early as 2018, and in 2019 the project was revised to reduce construction costs.

Reconstruction of residential buildings in Copenhagen and the Madrid, both in poor condition, continued in 2019 and is to be completed in 2020.

In 2019 the Ministry of Foreign Affairs held an architectural competition for the construction of the Embassy in Addis Ababa. In cooperation with the Czech Technical University and the President of the Inspireli Awards, an international architectural student competition was announced in 2018. In October 2019, based on a decision of an international jury and a Czech jury composed of experts, architectural public representatives and the investor, the project by students of the Slovak University of Technology in Bratislava, Kristína Boháčová and Jana Hájková, was selected as the winning design.



Visits and Meetings

V4 and Austerlitz Format

In mid-2019, the Czech Republic took the chair of the V4 Group. The Czech Presidency, led by the Czech diplomacy, carries the motto “V4 Reasonable Europe”, which emphasizes a rational approach, European themes and effective use of various formats for cooperation.

In 2019, the Czech Presidency hosted the V4 Presidents’ Summit with Serbia and Slovenia, a summit of the V4 Prime Ministers and representatives of the Western Balkans, and the V4 Foreign Ministers meeting with the Benelux. A number of important ministerial meetings were also held, such as the meeting of V4 Defence Ministers, the V4 Agriculture Ministers with Slovenia, Bulgaria, Romania, Croatia and Finland. V4 Interior Ministers also met with Austria.

At expert level, efforts continued to strengthen the Central European dimension of the V4 format, in particular, the involvement of Germany in negotiations on the priority topics of Czech diplomacy (EU enlargement, future of EU Eastern Policy).

Within the Austerlitz format (S3), the Czech Republic handed over its presidency to Slovakia in July 2019. During the year-long leadership of the S3 Group, it advocated the rationalization of the original commitments of the 2015 Austerlitz Declaration. As a result, the thematic scope of expert cooperation was expanded to include international law and development cooperation.

Cooperation within the strategic partnership with France was successful, especially in the field of defence, foreign affairs, interior, industry and trade, transport, agriculture, local development, culture and education, and also between government offices. It takes the form of high-level and working-level consultations, seminars, training courses, training and coordination events, joint projects, participation in fairs, art and industrial exhibitions. The intensive cooperation was highlighted by the visit of Foreign Minister Jean-Yves Le Drian to Prague in December.

France



Germany

In June 2019, an evaluation of the Czech-German Strategic Dialogue, launched in 2015, took place. In addition to the existing nine ministerial working groups, two new ones were added – energy and internal security. An extension of the dialogue to include development cooperation is also under preparation. The Strategic Dialogue work programme for the period 2019–2021, accentuating research, energy security, climate protection, transport and education, was jointly signed by both Foreign Ministers in Prague.

Great Britain

Although a change of government and early parliamentary elections took place on the British side in 2019, the Czech Republic maintained intensive bilateral contacts with Great Britain. The United Kingdom was visited by both Minister of Foreign Affairs Tomáš Petříček and Prime Minister Andrej Babiš. In December, President of the Czech Republic Miloš Zeman also visited London and led the delegation at the meeting of heads of state and government of NATO member states.

Korea

At the beginning of 2019, the Strategic Partnership Action Plan for the period 2019–2021 with the Republic of Korea was signed. This document extends the existing collaboration to include robotics, artificial intelligence, nanotechnology or lithium processing. The high level of mutual relations was confirmed by the meeting of the Minister of Foreign Affairs Tomáš Petříček with the Minister of Foreign Affairs Kang Kyung-wha on the margins of the GLOBSEC Forum in Bratislava.

China

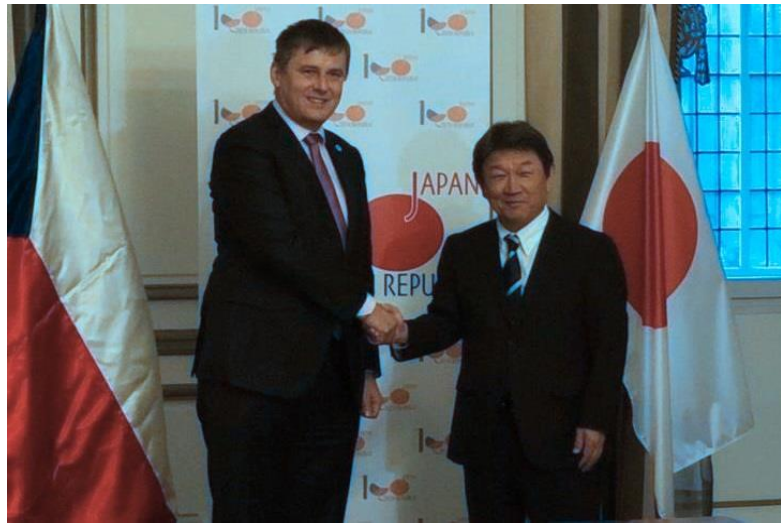
The Czech Republic sought to develop a comprehensive Czech-Chinese strategic dialogue. In February, consultations of Deputy Foreign Ministers took place in Beijing. The October meeting of the Czech-Chinese Joint Economic Committee, which met after a four-year pause, was also important. Both Czech President Miloš Zeman and Chairman of the Chamber of Deputies of the Czech Parliament Radek Vondráček informed their Chinese counterparts about the interest of the Czech Republic in organizing the first meeting of the Intergovernmental

Committee.

The Czech Republic is interested in concluding a strategic partnership with Japan, which would reflect progress in their cooperation. Czech officials emphasized this in all negotiations with their partners. The Chairman of the Senate of the Parliament of the Czech Republic Jaroslav Kubera and the Minister of Foreign Affairs Tomáš Petříček negotiated with the Speaker of the House of Representatives of the Japan's National Diet Tadamori Oshima. Prime Minister Andrej Babiš also expressed his interest in the strategic partnership at a meeting with Prime Minister Shinzo Abe in Tokyo in October 2019.

India

In 2019, a top-level dialogue with India continued as well. Both Prime Minister Andrej Babiš and Minister of Foreign Affairs Tomáš Petříček met with their counterparts and expressed their wish to conclude a strategic partnership between the two countries. Negotiations on the reintroduction of direct air connections between New Delhi and Prague continued. Thanks to the promotion of the Czech Republic, the number of Indian tourists increased; the interest in inter-university and scientific cooperation grew and the cooperation between small and medium-sized enterprises intensified. Several business missions from the fields of the digital economy, smart transport, communication technologies, water and waste management visited India.

As part of the commemoration of the 10th anniversary of the Eastern Partnership policy, two major events took place in Prague: the Conference on Economic Cooperation with the Eastern Partnership Countries in April and the Eastern Partnership Day in June, which provided an opportunity to reflect on the further development of this policy.

Despite tense relations with the Russian Federation at a multilateral level, the second Czech-Russian Discussion Forum took place in Moscow in June 2019. The discussion

forum was established as an apolitical, open discussion platform between the representatives of academic, expert and non-state structures.

Sub-Saharan Africa was one of the priority areas of the EU's foreign policy in 2019 and it therefore gains importance for the Czech Republic as well. In 2019, the Czech Republic set itself an objective that EU-Africa relations should better reflect the shift in the perception of partnerships towards greater equality and shared responsibility of both parties. This means moving from simply providing aid to strengthening the standard trade and economic cooperation as a more effective way of supporting the development of African countries. The Czech Republic's specific intention for the EU-Africa partnership is to involve more non-state actors, mainly from the private sector and civil society.

In connection with the government's strategy for the stabilization and socio-economic development of the Sahel, the Czech Republic opened an embassy in Bamako (the capital of Mali) in September 2019. It is the first diplomatic mission of Central and Eastern European countries in the region. Considerable attention of the Czech engagement is focused on security, mainly helping Mali in the fight against terrorism. In this context, the Czech Republic continued to train Malian security forces as part of the EU Training Mission (EUTM) in 2019. It was also preparing to take command of the entire mission in 2020.
