

## STUDENT VISA

Applicants for a long-term stay of over 90 days can submit the application and all required documents in person at the Czech Embassy.

Students arriving for a period longer than 90 days apply for a long-term residence permit for study purposes.

After receiving a letter of acceptance from one of the seven top universities in Prague, students have to apply for a student visa at the Czech Embassy in their country of origin, or in a country with a Czech Consulate. The process of acquiring a student visa takes 60–90 days to be finalised.

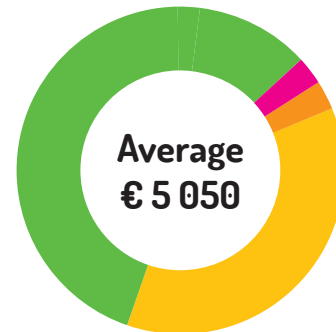

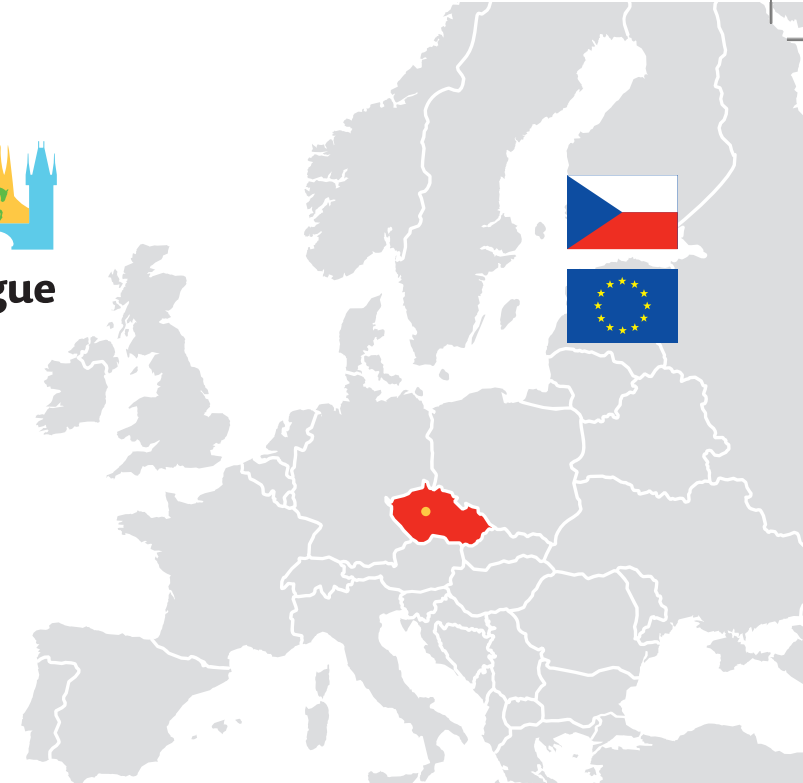

### Charles University in Prague

Established in 1348, Charles University in Prague (CU) is one of the oldest universities in the world. Today it has 17 faculties and almost 50 000 students. Around 8 000 of them are international students. CU offers more than 190 study programmes in foreign languages, primarily in English. The wide range of study areas includes e. g. biochemistry, geography, psychology, informatics, social sciences, history, medicine, mathematics and many more. Charles University is steadily ranked among the top 2% of universities worldwide according to the most respected international league tables and rankings (THE World University Rankings, QS World University Rankings by Subject, ARWU etc...)



### THE UNIVERSITY EDUCATION SYSTEM

in the Czech Republic is generally divided into 3 tiers:

- › Bachelor's degree (3 or 4 years/undergraduate)
- › Master's degree (1,5 or 2 years/graduate)
- › Doctoral degree (up to 5 years/post-graduate)

The academic year is usually divided into 2 semesters. The beginning of the new academic year starts usually in October.

Common requirements for application are:

- › Fully completed application form
- › Application fee according to the selected study programme
- › Certificate of previous studies / education

- › Interview admission exam (online / telephone / in person)
- › Certificate of English language proficiency (min B2)
- › Signed Curriculum Vitae
- › Letter of motivation
- › Copy of your passport, certified translation of Birth Certificate (or other document providing evidence of date and place of birth)
- › Recent Health Certificate (not older than 2 months) issued by an official health institution
- › Certified list of publications or prior application
- › Required field of scientific study of theme of dissertation \*

\* for doctoral (PhD) study

### Czech Technical University in Prague

The Czech Technical University (CTU) in Prague is a leading technical research university with a long tradition, located in the picturesque city of Prague. CTU offers undergraduate, graduate and doctoral programmes at 8 faculties and 1 institute of advanced studies in the fields of Civil, Mechanical and Electrical Engineering, Nuclear Sciences and Physical Engineering, Architecture, Transportation Sciences, Biomedical Engineering, Information Technology and Industrial Business and Management.
