King Abdullah university hospital is central governmental public educational hospital in Irbid and the north area of Jordan .The hospital serves mainly the underprivileged population with low economic status and covers all the residents in the cities of Irbid ,Ajloun,Jerash,Mafraq and Zarqa .The hospital has also been playing a major role in serving a considerable population of Syrian refugees in contractual cooperation with NGOs such as “Doctor without Borders “ considering its proximity to the borders (less than 8 km) and the Syrian refugee camps .

The gynaecology and neonatal units have been struggling to monitor complicated pregnancy cases and treat critical cases of pre-mature deliveries ,complicated or under developed infant cases due to :

*lack of necessary equipment

*malfunctioning and defects of the currently installed equipment

The equipment intended to supply shall help accepting complicated cases ,improve the treatment process of infants and help maximize gynaecology admission and observation
