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Opening message



Dear Readers,

As has long been the tradition, I am pleased to present to you this overview of the achievements and focus of Czech diplomacy in 2023. The deteriorating international environment increased the importance of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs as an integral part of our country's security apparatus. We finalized a revision of our relationships with Russia, cooperated with other government authorities to prepare the new Security Strategy of the Czech Republic, set up a new Sanctions Department at our Ministry and, in line with the newly effective Sanctions Act No. 1/2023, we included on the national sanctions list the first entities related to Russia's aggression in Ukraine.

In 2023, the watchword was an emphasis on security and our anchoring in the value system of the Western structures. Successful Presidency of the EU Council in 2022 helped us earn even more respect and strengthened our negotiating capacity in the EU. The hard work of our diplomats made us a strong voice at the UN.

Ukraine remained one of our foreign policy's main concerns in 2023. After the shock caused by the Russian invasion, followed by solidarity and unity of the democratic world, the year 2023 ushered in a much longer and harder phase. We continued to provide consistent assistance to Ukraine knowing that this support may be necessary on a long-term basis. Ukraine, struggling against the Russian war regime driven by an imperialist ideology, is in dire need of our backing. I would like to add that our support is led not only by our interest to maintain Ukraine's territorial integrity but also to maintain the rules-based international order and to safeguard our own security interests. In Ukraine, it is our security that is at stake - the fight in Ukraine is a fight for our security as well, and without effective assistance to Ukraine, even we cannot hold our own in the face of Russia's expansionism. We continue to support President Zelenskyy's ten-point peace plan, we support Ukraine in its aspirations to become a member of the EU and NATO as soon as it is possible, when the necessary conditions are met.

In the autumn of 2023, we were horrified by Hamas' brutal attacks against the State of Israel and its civilian population. Czechia expressed its full support for Israel's right to selfdefence in accordance with international law, including humanitarian law. It is a priority at the same time to address the critical humanitarian situation in Gaza. Czechia has long been advocating the two-state solution to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, but this primarily requires the presence of both parties at the negotiating table.

In 2023, we witnessed a shift towards authoritarian regimes in many countries. There are more and more of those turning to highly nationalistic, self-serving policies with little consideration for international implications. We were also facing a growing distrust from many countries of the socalled "Global South" whose pain inflicted by their own colonial past outweighs their fear of Russia's current aggressive colonialism. This is one of reasons why, in line with the new document Engaging in Africa: Czechia's



Strategy, I took one of my several-day trips abroad to Africa, to visit Angola and Zambia.

With regard to the current geopolitical situation, our foreign policy was grounded in new essential documents – the already mentioned Security Strategy, Defence Strategy, and the bilateral Defense Cooperation Agreement with the United States. Moreover, the Defence Financing Act was passed, guaranteeing our commitment to spend at least 2 per cent of our GDP on defence. A landmark event was Finland's entry into the North Atlantic Alliance, followed this year by Sweden. Czechia unreservedly supported the expansion of the North Atlantic Alliance to include the two Nordic countries as this is a crucial contribution to Euro-Atlantic security.

In 2023, we also engaged in the deepening of our transatlantic relationships as well as in the bilateral cooperation with our closest neighbours. We confirmed our willingness to take responsibility for the democratic and free world by making two fundamental decisions for the upcoming period – by announcing our candidacy for a nonpermanent seat on the United Nations Security Council for the 2032-2033 term and by hosting an informal meeting of NATO foreign ministers in spring 2024. We enhanced the good name of Czechia in human rights policy when, for the first time in history, we chaired the UN Human Rights *Council.* We were also entrusted with the chairmanship of the International Atomic Energy Agency, which dealt, among other things, with the risks of Iran's nuclear programme and the Zaporizhzhia power plant occupied by Russian troops. At the end of 2023, the plenary of the UN General Assembly adopted by consensus a Czech-sponsored resolution on human rights and digital technologies. It was the first initiative in the UN General Assembly to address comprehensively the issue of human rights and digital technologies.

It is not commonly known that Czechia belongs among the world's leading countries in terms of progress towards national sustainable development benchmarks – and yet, according to the regular UN SDG 4 scorecard report, our country ranked eighth out of 166 countries in 2023. Czechia has equally good prospects in foreign policy. We must not shy away from setting ourselves new tasks and objectives. We need to look out beyond our backyard, listen to our partners, and communicate our opinion and interest with clarity and confidence. Modern diplomacy achieves this through a combination of bilateral, regional, and multilateral contacts. It is active politically, commercially, by means of strategic communication and public diplomacy, development and transformation projects. The more solid in our values and creative in approach our team is, the more successful it will be in the long run.

I would like to express my thanks to you who participate in our foreign policy and diplomacy. And thank you all for your confidence in our foreign policy.

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The world in 2023

Russia's aggression against Ukraine was a challenge to the European continent and the world at large. We had to defend ourselves against the destructive practices of Russia, including the way it sowed the seeds of conflict and instability across the Western Balkans as well as in the Middle East, Central Asia, and Africa. We looked for the best ways to help Ukraine – and we turned our words of support into practical action on many occasions. In autumn, the Hamas movement perpetrated a terror attack against Israel. The toll, in Israelis killed and tortured, was the heaviest since Israel's foundation, and the resulting Gaza crisis came to loom large on the international agenda. Africa's Sahel was increasingly destabilized, tensions in the Taiwan Strait grew, and Iran and North Korea reinforced their ties with Russia. The divisions between liberal democracies and authoritarian regimes did not boil over into an all-out armed conflict. However, hybrid warfare was a constant presence, ever more intensive and efficient in its use of controlled migration, propaganda, intelligence operations, and economic and cyber tools.

The Euro-Atlantic space sought to bolster its unity and its sense of belonging together, as well as to improve its military and energy capacities. NATO focused on the security of the allies, especially those on the eastern wing. Finland became a member and Sweden was preparing to join. The Alliance inaugurated a new cooperation format: the NATO-Ukraine Council. It set out to systematically deal with the challenges of China's geopolitical and regional influence and deepened its cooperation with Australia, New Zealand, Japan, and the Republic of Korea. Transatlantic unity benefited from events such as the EU-US summit in October and the EU-Canada summit in November, as well as from mutual coordination in respect of Ukraine and solidarity with Israel following the Hamas attack. On the other hand, what hampered the relationship was the absence of agreement on issues relevant to trade in steel, aluminium, and critical minerals in the context of the United States Inflation Reduction Act of 2022.

The EU adopted new packages of sanctions intended to thwart Russia's ability to continue with its aggression



against Ukraine. The sanctions targeted individuals, entities and sectors, including Iranian producers and suppliers of technologies and UAVs. The Union helped Ukraine through the new European Peace Facility and by means of direct budgetary support. It also began to work on its security commitments to Ukraine. A huge step forward was the opening of accession talks with Ukraine, Moldova, and Bosnia and Herzegovina, the granting of candidate status to Georgia, and the opening of the first cluster of accession talks with North Macedonia and Albania.

The countries that maintained a neutral stance in the face of Russia's aggression considered how to exploit the move towards bipolar geopolitical system to advance their interests and increase their regional and global stature (geographically, the neutrals represented one third of the world's population). There were new members joining two moderately anti-Western organizations: BRICS (Egypt, Ethiopia, Iran, and the United Arab Emirates) and the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (Iran). Negotiations on global forums became a drawn out process often brought to a halt by blockages. The international system obviously called for reforms that would give each country enough elbow room while promoting respect for international principles and rules. The main global challenges included the impacts of the war in Ukraine, ranging from inflation to food security, economic and energy security issues, and migration.

Rapid technological development brings many opportunities but also many threats. New technologies, whether by themselves or when applied in sectors such as security, defence or space exploration, build bridges across the world, but they also serve geopolitical competition. Artificial intelligence opens up unprecedented opportunities for social control and invasion of privacy with all the attendant risks to human rights and fundamental freedoms.

Impacts of the climate change trouble an increasing number of countries. The 2023 UN Climate Change Conference (CPO28) in Dubai was hailed as a breakthrough. The participating countries agreed to transition away from fossil fuels, triple Security begins at home the global renewable power capacity, double the annual rate of energy efficiency improvements by 2030, and to operationalize a loss and damage fund for the most vulnerable countries. The EU had one of the leading roles in the negotiations and sought to follow up with new partnerships and projects under the Global Gateway strategy. At the same time, it looked for a balanced approach to the implementation of its own climate targets under the European Green Deal.

Russia's aggression against Ukraine stressed the importance of diplomacy as a key element of our country's security system. Czech diplomats are on the front line defending Czech interests in international organizations (notably the UN and its agencies, NATO, the EU, and the OSCE). The Ministry of Foreign Affairs, together with the Office of the Government. Ministries of Defence and the Interior, the intelligence services and other institutions, plays an indispensable role in strengthening our security and resilience. In 2023, the Foreign Ministry coordinated the drafting and approval of the new Security Strategy, drafted the national Sanctions Act, prepared and approved a review of relations with Russia, and contributed to the preparation of the Defence Strategy, the Defense Cooperation Agreement with the United States and the Defence Financing Act guaranteeing the country's commitment to spend at least 2 per cent of GDP on defence.

Since its entry into force at the beginning of 2023, the Act on Restrictive Measures against Certain Serious Conduct in International Relations (Sanctions Act) provides for a mechanism enabling the inclusion of entities on the EU sanctions lists as well as on the national sanctions list concurrently with or independently of the EU sanctions regime. With the help of this legislation, the Government decided in 2023 to include seven entities on the national sanctions list and nominate six of them for inclusion on the EU sanctions list.

In June, the Government approved the Report on the Review of Relations with Russia. Russia is likely to continue to pose threats and risks to Czechia, the Euro-Atlantic region as well as globally, at least in the medium-term run, and its

aggression in domestic as well as foreign policy may become more intense and sophisticated. The Report outlines specific ongoing tasks carried out by our diplomacy, both individually and in coordination with our foreign partners.

At the end of June, the Government approved the new Security Strategy of the Czech Republic. This text not only updates the 2015 strategy but also engages the professional community and general public in questions of national security in an unprecedented manner. The Security Strategy openly articulates threats and their manifestations in our daily life and puts Russian aggression in Ukraine in the context of the changing international order. It portrays the complex nature of security and modern warfare and points to the threats arising from economic dependencies, climate change and the misuse of new technologies. In October, the Security Strategy was followed up by the Defence Strategy; further subconcepts or strategies are being drafted.

Czechia is a member of 81 international governmental organizations. In January, it resigned from the former Eastern Bloc's organizations with a strong Russian presence – the International Investment Bank and the International Bank for Economic Co-operation. Czech diplomacy was active in international organizations and initiatives, above all on important questions of Europe's security and prosperity, such as the containment of Russia and Russia's influence, and the promotion of the UN Charter and rules-based international order. We integrated and coordinated our steps with those of our EU allies and close partners, and across our own public administration system.

The adoption of the new Security Strategy, with the related Defence Strategy and Defence Financing Act (which commits us to spend at least 2 per cent of our GDP on defence), shows how seriously Czechia takes the question of building its own security and relationships with allies in the North Atlantic Treaty Organization. With this sense of urgency, we engaged in steps to reinforce NATO internally, including the battlegroups in Slovakia, Poland, and the Baltic countries, and in the Alliance's policies towards its partners and towards its

systemic adversaries and threats. We promptly ratified the accession of Finland and Sweden and led the way in critical equipment purchases and other assistance to Ukraine. We contributed to NATO's Comprehensive Assistance Package (CAP) for Ukraine, including non-lethal military assistance and future transformation of the country's defence sector. In this context, the Alliance accepted our offer to host an informal meeting of NATO Foreign Ministers in May 2024.

Support for Ukraine was also the keynote of our activity in the European Union. We continued to build on our successful Presidency term, during which the EU had laid the foundations for its policy in respect of Ukraine. At the same time, we worked through arrangements such as the Friends of the Western Balkans to drive home the fact that integration of well-prepared Western Balkan and East European countries would be the crucial moment for stability and security across Europe, as well as for the geopolitical weight of the Union. We kept promoting the alignment of EU policies and tools to make sure that the Union is as united as possible in dealing with third countries, especially the unfriendly ones. In this connection, we supported the Union's intensive contacts with close partners – most importantly, a strong transatlantic unity between the EU, on the one part, and the United States and Canada, on the other.

We pressed for the most effective measures against Russia – restrictions on dual-use exports, ban on the operations of Russia's disinformation media, ban on the imports of Russian diamonds, and steps against sanctions circumvention. We played a significant role in setting up a new regime of sanctions against Iran to prohibit exports of goods and technologies used in the construction and production of UAVs as well as cooperation with Iranian individuals and entities involved in the UAV production programme.

Our support to Ukraine was comprehensive and coordinated. Czechia was one of its main protagonists in the Union. Our support had a military and defence dimension as well as a humanitarian, development, economic, and political dimension. It involved arms supplies, training of Ukrainian



troops, defence industry cooperation, as well as support for Ukraine's accession process, President Zelenskyy's 10-point peace plan, the concept of a special tribunal for the punishment of the crime of aggression, and the steps towards using frozen Russian assets for the benefit of Ukraine.

We engaged in the EU enlargement policy to help increase the pace of enlargement by means of accelerated integration and phasing-in. We strongly supported the Union's approach to Israel and advocated Israel's right to self-defence in very clear terms. In respect of the South Caucasus, we supported the efforts of the EU and the United States to mediate a lasting peace settlement between Armenia and Azerbaijan.


We engaged in the <u>Union's military and civilian missions</u> in accordance with our national strategic documents, and with the EU Strategic Compass and Civilian CSDP Compact. We were open about the fact that our main concern was to ensure our own defence capability and also NATO's deterrence and collective defence. Another priority on the Czech diplomatic agenda was the cyber and digital sector, where we drew attention to the human rights perspective. We took part in the review of the Implementing Guidelines of the EU Cyber Diplomacy Toolbox. We advocate the use of the Toolbox not only for defence but also for prevention, namely for capacitybuilding in third countries. We participated in the Union's cyber dialogues with the United States, United Kingdom, Japan, Indo-Pacific, and with Latin America and the Caribbean.

However, the main platform for our cyber security activities was the United Nations, namely the General Assembly's First Committee and its Open-Ended Working Group on Security of and in the Use of Information and Communication Technologies. Here, we spoke up against the attempts of Russia and China to divert attention from the established principles and standards and enlisted the support of third countries for our cause. In November, we successfully cosponsored (together with Mexico, Netherlands, Maldives, and the Republic of South Africa) the first ever General Assembly resolution on promotion and protection of human rights in the

In May 2023, Czechia officially presented its candidacy for non-permanent membership of the UN Security Council for the 2032-2033 term. In November, we were elected to serve on the UNESCO Executive Board in the 2023-2027 term – it was a great success to win this seat, as we did, for the fourth time in our country's existence. We also won seats on the UN Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice (for the 2024-2026 term), the UN Forum on Forests, and on the UNWTO Executive Council. The town of Žatec and the landscape of Saaz Hops became Czechia's seventeenth site inscribed on the prestigious UNESCO World Heritage List.

Our first ever Presidency of the UN Human Rights Council was very successful. This prestigious role involved presiding over three regular sessions (in March, June, and September), one special session (in May, on the Sudan), and many intersessional activities such as an interactive dialogue on Ukraine or an informal meeting of the Council's members held in Prague in November. We pursued three priorities: better prevention, broader participation, and greater efficiency; for example, we forged a consensus in favour of more systematic use of digital tools (remote participation modalities) and established some practical measures (efficiency). At the same time, UN members presented their recommendations concerning Czechia's human rights situation for the fourth cycle of the Universal Periodic Review (a country comes up for review every five years). In autumn, we launched our campaign for election to the Council for the 2025-2027 term.

Czechia worked in coordination with the EU and close partners in the context of negotiations concerning a number of conflicts, not limited to Russia's aggression in Ukraine and the Gaza crisis. We supported the UN Secretary General's steps towards reform in the peace and security pillar, effective management and budget process, and towards the development of the Pact for the Future - a document to be adopted at the Summit of the Future in 2024 and designed to promote multilateral approach to global problems. The importance we attach to multilateralism was underlined by the very senior level of our presence at the opening of the 78th regular session of the UN General Assembly (President and Foreign Minister). For the first time ever, we served a full-year term at the head of the Board of Governors of the International Atomic Energy Agency (starting from September 2022); here, the greatest challenges were Iran's nuclear programme and Russia's occupation of the Zaporizhzhia Nuclear Power Plant. Participation of Czechia's Minister of Labour and Social Affairs in the 67th session of the Commission on the Status of Women was one of the occasions on which we spoke up for gender equality and women's rights.

In the area of international justice, we also looked for opportunities to support Ukraine in the face of Russia's aggression. We contributed to the International Criminal

Court financially as well as by providing human resources, namely a public prosecutor and forensic experts specialized in investigating war crimes. In the Core Group (which met for the first time in Prague in January 2023), we take part in developing the concept of a special tribunal for the crime of aggression. In the International Court of Justice, we stood with Ukraine in its defence against Russia's allegations of genocide in the Luhansk and Donetsk regions. We support the initiative to negotiate a convention on international cooperation in the investigation and prosecution of genocide, crimes against humanity, war crimes and other international crimes; this instrument should complement and develop the fragmentary rules of the present international law.

In May, the Council of Europe summit in Revkjavík established a Register of Damage Caused by the Aggression of the Russian Federation against Ukraine. Czechia was a founding member of the Register and played an active role in three rounds of negotiations on the rules for its functioning. Deportations and forcible transfers of Ukrainian children to Russia were another issue on which we felt and acted strongly, both in the Council of Europe and in the Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe, where a Czech expert from Prague's Charles University led an independent team. Czechia was equally active in other OSCE dimensions, including election observation missions and the Informal Working Group on Cybersecurity. Our political and financial support for Ukraine included two specific financial contributions: to the Support Programme for Ukraine and to the Special Representative's office.

In the area of development and humanitarian aid, our work at the expert as well as ministerial level promoted private sector involvement, reform of multilateral development banks, use of modern technologies in disaster prevention, and the interlinking of humanitarian and development activities. In the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development, the Czech development cooperation system underwent a <u>peer review</u> by Irish and Italian partners. In the

OECD, like in the UN and EU, Czechia participated in preparatory meetings prior to the COP28 UN Climate Change Conference: the Minister of Industry and Trade attended three conferences to discuss issues such as the financing of Europe's energy transition, nuclear energy, and critical minerals.

Relations with countries in our neighbourhood remained very good throughout the year. With Germany, we coordinate closely on important security and EU issues, a process made easier by the format of our intergovernmental dialogue as well as by think tank cooperation, the Discussion Forum, and the Future Fund that celebrated its 25th anniversary in 2023. Cooperation with Bavaria and Saxony became even more intensive and culminated in the first Czech-German Regional Forum. Poland is our steadfast ally in our drive to assist Ukraine and in our approach to Russia. Preparations for a summit meeting began immediately after the new Polish government took office. In April, the Czech and Slovak governments held the first joint meeting after a lapse of four years. After the autumn parliamentary elections in Slovakia, we continued to work together closely across the governmental as well as non-governmental sectors. With Hungary, we differ radically on some foreign policy issues; however, we took the opportunities offered by multilateral negotiations and regional arrangements (Visegrad Group, Central 5) to maintain a dialogue. With Austria, relations are growing ever more cordial, as illustrated by mutual visits by the Presidents and parliamentary speakers of both countries, and Minister Lipavský's visit to Vienna and Dachau. The Austerlitz Format remains an important part of relations with Austria and Slovakia. Contacts with Switzerland have deepened as the Czech embassy in Bern serves as NATO's Contact Point Embassy.

Relations with Ukraine had long been among the most dynamic ones, and they deepened even further following Russia's aggression. This is obvious from the frequency of meetings between the two Foreign Ministers, and also from the April visit by President Pavel (the first head of state to visit Dnipro in eastern Ukraine), the Prague visit by President Zelenskyy and parliamentary speaker Stefanchuk, and the visits to Ukraine by the speakers of both Czech parliamentary chambers and by Czechia's First Lady, or the meeting of the Prime Ministers in Chişinău in April. Our bilateral assistance to Ukraine was interlinked with multilateral efforts. It involved delivering humanitarian aid and laying the groundwork for Ukraine's economic reconstruction, but also receiving 400,000 refugees. Our cyber security cooperation deepened as well.

Relations with the United States were similarly dynamic; after all, they centred around Ukraine on many occasions. Together, we organized arms supplies and helped secure Ukraine's energy infrastructure against Russian attacks. US partners took part in Czechia's training programme for Ukrainian pilots and in refugee assistance. The commitment to supporting Ukraine was one of the chief outcomes of Minister Lipavský's visit and the strategic dialogue between the Czech Foreign Ministry and the US Department of State in Washington in



Strategic partners May; the other important results being Czechia's accession to the Artemis Accords and the inauguration of our Cyber Dialogue. Czechia's Ministry of Defence and Ministry of Industry and Trade held dialogues with their US counterparts. The conclusion and entry into force of the Agreement on Defense Cooperation was a historic moment. As the next step, the Czech government approved a plan to purchase 24 F-35 supersonic combat aircraft of the new generation and the US side continued with its delivery of helicopters to Czechia.

In the European Union, Czechia develops a strategic partnership with France. We negotiated a three-year Action Plan providing for cooperation between our Foreign Ministries and other government authorities. France was visited by Minister Lipavský, and also by President Pavel towards the end of the year. Our dialogue with Italy was intense, as illustrated by the Prague visit by Prime Minister Meloni and by President Pavel's visit to Rome. We made a special effort to strengthen our ties with the Nordic and Baltic countries as we are of like mind with them on most issues. LNG supply from Norway and the Netherlands improved our energy security. We built up our cooperation with Portugal in Africa, deepened relations with Greece in the defence industry sector, and strengthened our ties with Romania and Croatia through political dialogues. Both countries, as well as Bulgaria, appreciated our support of their integration into the Schengen Area.

Strategic partnerships become an even more valuable asset in times of war. We deepened ours, both through everyday diplomatic work and through documents providing for institutional cooperation. The Czech government's policy statement and its undertaking to develop relations with the United Kingdom was put into practice by the three-year Statement of Intent Delivery Plan for partnership between Czechia's Foreign Ministry and the United Kingdom's FCDO, signed in June. MoUs on cooperation with UK partners were signed by the Ministry of the Interior (police cooperation), Ministry of Industry and Trade (energy, SMRs), and the Ministry of Transport (high-speed railways). Lipavský had three meetings with his UK counterparts, and the two Prime Ministers met in Granada, Spain. To reaffirm our close relationship with Israel, the Foreign Minister, Prime Minister and the speakers of both Czech parliamentary chambers visited the country immediately after the Hamas attack. The fifth round of intergovernmental consultations with Israel was postponed due to the situation in the country; however, Israel's Foreign Minister visited Prague and the Deputy Foreign Ministers met for political consultations in Jerusalem. As regards Asia, the Prime Minister of the Republic of Korea visited Prague and Czechia's Prime Minister visited Japan. In the context of NATO's emerging partnership with these two countries, Czechia advocates the closest possible cooperation - the threats the two countries face in the Atlantic and Pacific are similar, by their nature, to those that we face in Europe.

The Western Balkans and Eastern Europe remain the priority regions of our foreign policy. We confirmed this by supporting the EU enlargement policy and candidate countries, as well as by our visits: the Foreign Minister visited North Macedonia and the Speaker of the Czech Parliament's Chamber of Deputies visited Georgia. The most senior visitors to Prague were the Presidents of Moldova and Georgia, the Prime Minister of Armenia, the Foreign Minister of Kosovo, and the Speaker of Azerbaijan's parliament. Our cyber dialogue with Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Moldova, and Georgia made progress.

Aware that the global situation was partly our responsibility and that the world should be made more alert to the way Russia behaved in Europe, Czech diplomacy worked purposefully to develop or initiate prospective and tailored partnerships across continents in coordination with our EU and NATO allies. In Africa and the Indo-Pacific, we implemented the national strategies launched in 2022. Our activity in respect of the African continent involved mainly visits (some of them being the first ever visits to Czechia) and <u>strategic communication projects</u>. In the late spring and early summer, the Interior Minister visited Senegal, Ghana, and

Czechs on international missions Rwanda, and the Foreign Minister visited Angola and Zambia. In autumn, Ethiopia, Kenya, Ghana, and the Ivory Coast received the first ever visit by Czechia's Prime Minister, and the Prime Minister of Ethiopia made a reciprocal visit to Prague. The President of Mozambique became the first sub-Saharan head of state to visit Czechia after more than twenty years. We developed cyber dialogues with Ghana, Senegal, and Zambia.

Cooperation with Asia was even more dynamic. We began to prepare new strategic partnerships with India and Vietnam and entered into an enhanced partnership with Uzbekistan. We cooperate on cyber security issues with Indonesia, Thailand, and Vietnam. Prime Minister Fiala visited Indonesia, Philippines, Singapore, Vietnam, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, and Mongolia, and the Foreign Minister made a visit to India. The Foreign Ministers of Mongolia and Vietnam visited Prague.

We increased our focus on Latin America, a continent that has embraced values similar to our own. At the EU-CELAC summit, Czechia was represented not only by the Foreign Minister but by the Prime Minister as well. Minister Lipavský used this opportunity for bilateral meetings with his counterparts from Costa Rica, Peru, Guatemala, and the Dominican Republic. Consultations with Mexico and Brazil at the level of Deputy Foreign Ministers took place during the year. We deepened cyber security cooperation with Colombia and other countries. The signing of the EU-Chile Advanced Framework Agreement was a step significant for our future relations.

To promote the good name of Czechia in the world, we annually provide monetary donations to complement our membership in international organizations. These donations are a foreign policy instrument which works in synergy with our interests and candidacies. In 2023, we contributed CZK 49 million to support nearly 80 projects of almost 40 organizations focused mainly on activities relating to Russia's aggression against Ukraine, such as investigations into war crimes and crimes against humanity, strengthening the capacities of countries under Russia's pressure, and support for the Office of the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights and the International Criminal Court.

Another foreign policy tool is Czech participation in international missions and operations led by the EU, UN, NATO, OSCE, and ad hoc coalitions. In the case of the EU, these include both civilian and military missions. The civilian missions focus on crisis management, most commonly on building customs and border protection capacities, preventing conflicts, countering organized crime and smuggling, reforming national security sectors, monitoring the judiciary, and promoting the rule of law. The task of the military missions is to maintain security and stability. In 2023, 19 Czech soldiers and police officers served in UN peacekeeping missions, 47 Czechs served in EU missions, 44 in NATO missions (outside the Euro-Atlantic area), and 73 in other formats. They were mainly deployed in Eastern Europe, the Western Balkans, the Middle East, and the Sahel. We were present in Armenia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Cyprus, Georgia,

the Golan Heights, Iraq, Israel, Kosovo, Libya, Mali, the Mediterranean, Moldova, Niger, Serbia, Sinai, Somalia, South Sudan, and Ukraine. Czechs have a long-standing record of serving as <u>election observers on OSCE and EU missions</u>, with almost 90 observers deployed in 2023.

As part of its development programme, Czechia contributes to the implementation of the 2030 Agenda and the Sustainable Development Goals at the UN and ranks among the top countries in the annual assessment of progress towards these goals. In the last assessment, Czechia ranked eighth out of 166 countries. In 2023, we supported the implementation of the 2030 Agenda with 17 projects carried out via our embassies. We worked with the UN Development Programme and the World Food Programme to assist with climate issues and humanitarian diplomacy in Ethiopia, Sudan, and Ukraine. Ten young Czech volunteers signed up to help the UN Volunteers. Our joint assistance with the EU comprised projects on agriculture in Bosnia and Herzegovina and Zambia and on national parks in Georgia.

In the area of bilateral development cooperation, we had a budget of CZK 717 million which we used primarily in our <u>six</u> <u>priority countries</u> through the involvement of companies, NGOs, and universities. We also launched the government's two-year Humanitarian, Stabilization, Reconstruction and Economic Assistance Programme for Ukraine worth CZK 500 million under which we contributed CZK 280 million in support of public infrastructure and internally displaced Ukrainians and Moldovans. In autumn, we launched a twoyear training programme for Ukrainian transport pilots together with the Ministry of Transport, Ministry of Industry and Trade, and the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports, and with a financial contribution from the United States; the first 20 students enrolled in the programme in the same year. Czech and Ukrainian schools also developed new partnerships.

The humanitarian aid budget of CZK 165 million covered 46 projects in 25 countries affected by natural disasters (earthquakes in Turkey, Syria, and Morocco; floods in Malawi, Slovenia, and Madagascar; and fires in Greece), conflicts and

Business, science and research forced displacement (Ethiopia, Iraq, Lebanon, Moldova, Myanmar, Sudan, Syria, and Ukraine) or complex crises (the Sahel and Zambia). We took part in aiding Africa through the United Nations Office for Disaster Risk Reduction and the World Food Programme.

The Transformation Cooperation Programme is Czechia's practical instrument to support human rights, independent media, freedom of speech, and civil society. In 2023, its budget was CZK 100 million of which CZK 80 million was earmarked for projects of Czech NGOs in <u>priority countries</u> and another CZK 20 million for projects in Ukraine implemented by Czech or local organizations. We promptly issued visas to persecuted human rights defenders from Russia and Belarus and provided long-term residency support through the government's Civil Society Programme. We continued to offer assistance to vulnerable defenders of democracy and human rights in Burma.

Our diplomacy supported Czech companies of all sizes and sectors and helped them to find business opportunities, largely in more distant markets. Information on economic development and opportunities abroad was made available to the professional community and general public through the <u>website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs</u> as well as through the export.cz website, social media networks, and the <u>Modern Economic Diplomacy magazine</u>.

Over 240 economic diplomacy projects were implemented worldwide within the <u>PROPED</u> economic diplomacy programme, which has again proved its importance in promoting the interests of companies. Fifteen countries participated in projects within the <u>PROPEA</u> programme promoting economic activities. This relatively new instrument is designed to help Czech companies gain a more lasting or significant foothold abroad; it uses local experts and minimises risks. In addition to the PROPED and PROPEA services, our network of embassies and CzechTrade offices abroad offered, in nearly 100 countries, services according to the established catalogue of the services provided through the Client Centre and the single support network abroad.



The Ministry of Foreign Affairs updated its <u>Global Industry</u> <u>Opportunities Map</u>. Together with embassies, the Czech Chamber of Commerce, Confederation of Industry or other partners, it organized a number of online and face-to-face events and conferences for Czech companies. The most important ones included the Health Forum Czech Republic -Africa with the participation of health ministers from African partner countries and the Investment Forum with major sovereign funds from the Gulf countries.

Our diplomacy worked closely with regional export specialists at the regional branches of the Chamber of Commerce and, together with the Confederation of Industry, organized annual consultations of all economic diplomats with Czech companies. In response to Russia's aggression, we identified solutions for Ukraine's economic recovery and prepared leaflets to promote them. With the University of West Bohemia in Pilsen, we continued to create regional-sector analyses funded by the <u>Technology Agency of the Czech Republic</u>.

Our attention increasingly turns to research, development, and innovation. This area is crucially important to our economy, both as a component contributing to the added value of Czech production and exports and as an important tool for promoting bilateral relations, including development cooperation as well as security. To internationalize Czech research, development and innovation and to commercialize their results, we supported the involvement of our academic and research institutions as well as innovative companies in foreign projects, connected them with progressive partners and helped disseminate information about Czech science and education. We also sought to bring in foreign scientists and researchers to Czech institutions and research infrastructure.

Strategic communication is one of our priorities because it actively and positively informs the domestic and foreign public about the foreign policy issues that are important to us. To do so, we use topic-based communication campaigns, social networks, discussions with students, lectures, and activities in the public space. We seek close coordination across the state administration, with foreign partners, the non-governmental sector, and journalists. The year's highlights included the

exhibition Czechia Helps dedicated to our humanitarian, development and transformation projects, events taking place in the EU and NATO countries to commemorate Russia's invasion of Ukraine, the Women in Diplomacy project, communication about Czechia's membership in the EU and NATO, and a debate with university students organized in cooperation with the Junior Diplomatic Initiative at the University of Economics. Other successful programmes included the Cool Czechia and Duke Wenceslas Future Leaders programmes, which introduce Czechia to future young leaders and influencers from Africa and the EU neighbourhood by means of hosted visits. A separate area where we dynamically develop contacts with close partners is the fight against disinformation.

Strategic communication is indirectly bolstered by lively contacts with think tanks which also deepen diplomatic expertise. In 2023, Czechia joined the newly established Brussels Institute for Geopolitics (BIG) and continued cooperation with ThinkVisegrad, GLOBSEC, the European Council on Foreign Relations (ECFR), and the Prague offices of German foundations. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs approaches Czech think tanks and academics, offering them projects managed by the Technology Agency of the Czech Republic, commissioning operational analyses and, above all, providing subsidies from funds earmarked for foreign policy priorities. In 2023, the Ministry provided these subsidies, worth CZK 3.2 million, to 15 projects of 11 organizations: Association for International Affairs, Czech School without Borders, People in Need, EUROPEUM Institute, European Values, European Youth Parliament, Gulag.cz, Jagello 2000, Václav Havel Library, Forum 2000 Foundation and Prague Security Studies Institute. In addition, the Ministry had joint projects with the Institute of International Relations.

As part of the public diplomacy, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs organized over five hundred events, either alone or with partners (mainly the Czech Centres): workshops, discussion panels on various topics and anniversaries, literary meetings, concerts, and exhibitions. The traditional ones included an international conference in the memory of Holocaust victims, MFA awards

an event hosted by the Minister of Foreign Affairs in the memory of Jan Masaryk, a project within the Central European Cultural Platform (this time focusing on gender politics and multicultural society), and the Open Day of the Czernin Palace with a record number of visitors. New events included a panel exhibition of fifteen world-famous Czech brands and inventions (such as Jawa, Zetor, Škoda, contact lenses, Moser, and Remoska electric cooking pan), a discussion by three female scientists on the occasion of the International Day of Women and Girls, and a Czech-American cultural evening.

Minister Lipavský presented eight <u>Gratias Agit</u> awards for promoting the good name of Czechia abroad and seventeen <u>Medals of Merit in Diplomacy</u>).

Many of these awards were presented to Czech compatriots long living abroad. With as many as 130 compatriot events, 2023 was actually a record-breaking year; a study mapping the contribution of the Czech diaspora to our country is being prepared. The compatriots were thanked for their activity not only by the Foreign Minister, but also by the President of the Czech Republic and the speakers of both Czech parliamentary chambers during their visits. The important topics for the compatriots include the correspondence vote and wider options for acquiring Czech citizenship, better conditions in education, support for Czech language teaching and flexible communication and information. The key issue will be the future linking of the compatriot and Czech national school systems.





The successful projects of 2023 include a pilot Czech language camp for Ukrainian and Croatian children, a course on compatriot methodology, and a Czech language course for compatriots. Czechia acquired the Češka beseda building in Belgrade and opened a Czech House there. The XV International Conference of Czech Schools Abroad was held at the Czernin Palace and a biennial conference on the role of the diaspora and the relationship of compatriots to their homeland took place in the Senate. CZK 42 million was earmarked for donations to compatriot associations for the

Diplomatic network preservation of Czech cultural heritage abroad. The Comenius School in Vienna (150th anniversary of its foundation) or the compatriots in Banat, Romania (200 years of settlement) received CZK 3 million each, and approximately the same amount was used for the dissemination of Czech studies in the world. The compatriots in other countries also commemorated important anniversaries, both long-standing and new: 150 years since the birth of the Czech mayor of Chicago, Antonín Čermák, 100 years since the founding of the Czech section at the Lycée Carnot in Dijon, 70 years of the Czech and Slovak Association in Western Australia, 30 years of the Association in Košice, 20 years of the first Czech School without Borders in Paris and the Czech Association in Florence, 15 years of the Italian-Czech project Val di Ledro, and 10 years of the Czech school in Florence.

At the end of 2023, Czechia had diplomatic relations with 197 countries around the world. We developed our relations and promoted our interests abroad through a diplomatic network of 117 posts, including <u>92 embassies</u>, <u>seven permanent</u> <u>missions and delegations</u> to international organizations, <u>17</u> <u>consulates general</u>, <u>three consular agencies</u> and <u>two posts of</u> <u>other types</u>. This official diplomatic presence was complemented by <u>Czech Centres</u> (28 branches), <u>223 honorary</u> <u>consulates</u>, an integrated network of the Ministry of Industry and Trade, and <u>CzechTourism</u> representations.




Czech nationals travelling or living abroad use the consular services of our embassies and consulates. We keep improving and modernizing the range of services offered. Czechs are able to vote at embassies and consulates in national parliamentary and presidential elections and European Parliament elections. In January's presidential elections, we had 111 special electoral districts outside Czechia in each of the two rounds. The turnout hit a record high: more than 16,000 in the first round and as many as 23,000 in the second one (the previous presidential elections had a turnout of 12,000 in the first round and 17,000 in the second round). The greatest numbers of people cast their ballot at embassies in London, Brussels, Vienna, Berlin, and Bern. The Foreign Ministry managed the standard election-day procedures as well as the preparatory stages, including voter registration and responses to questions.



Travelling abroad In 2023, foreign travel returned to its pre-Covid levels. Czechs made 6 million visits abroad (5 million in 2022). The top summer destinations were Croatia (800,000 Czech visitors), Greece (640,000), Italy (470,000), Slovakia (380,000), Turkey (300,000), Austria (210,000), Bulgaria (190,000), and Spain. The sale of package holidays grew (by 10 per cent) and so did the demand for quality services. In terms of packages sold through travel agents, Spain, Italy, Greece, Turkey, Egypt, and Bulgaria topped the list, while Portugal, the Azores, and Albania increased most steeply year-on-year. Czechs rediscovered Poland as a popular destination for holidays and shopping trips.

Our diplomacy was well prepared for the summer season. We opened consular agencies in Rijeka, Split and Burgas, and provided extra staff to the honorary consulate in Barcelona. We had Czech police officers assisting their local colleagues in Croatia (Omiš and Vodice) and Bulgaria (Nesebar and Primorsko).

Our honorary consuls, with their professionalism and wealth of local knowledge, were a great asset in resolving the diverse situations in which Czech tourists tend to find themselves. The Foreign Ministry's call centre (Consular Operations and Information Centre) continued to improve its services. The plan is to develop our call centre into an emergency call hub handling the various helplines so far operated by Czech embassies and consulates. A successful media campaign inspired almost 208,000 Czech travellers to register in the DROZD application (in contrast to 91,000 registrations in 2022). The DROZD application proved useful especially in situations when it was necessary to evacuate tourists (the Rhodes and Corfu wildfires were the worst emergency, together with the tropical storm and floods in the Republic of Korea). To keep improving the standard of the services, the Foreign Ministry worked closely with the Ministry of the Interior and the Ministry of Health, and with travel agents and insurers.



Sadly, comparison of statistical data for 2022 and 2023 shows a rise in the number of deaths abroad (154 against 139), hospitalizations (118 against 91), crime victims (369 against 330) and arrests for drug-related offences (52 against 23).




Visas to visit Czechia Consular cases typically occur in capital cities, on islands and in seaside resorts, and they typically involve theft or robbery. We also have an increasing number of overconfident hikers and extreme tourists and an increasing number of medical repatriations (including for mental health issues). A new phenomenon are fatal road accidents in Indonesia, where tourists driving hired cars and scooters find themselves at the losing end in the complicated traffic. The Foreign Ministry consistently and responsibly updates <u>the travel warnings and</u> <u>advisories on its website</u>. We have regular debates with EU partners on issues such as consular assistance to EU citizens in third countries, the EU emergency travel document, and cases of stranding abroad and forced marriages. In the light of these debates, it is obvious that the assistance Czech nationals are getting from our diplomacy is above the EU standard.

The flow of incoming visitors from countries whose nationals need a visa to enter Czechia was affected by the lasting suspension of visa issuance to Russian and Belarusian nationals (except for family members of Czech nationals/EU citizens, and except for dissidents) and by a new decision excluding Russian and Belarusian athletes from sports competitions in Czechia. The lifting of Covid restrictions in China did not immediately lead to a significant increase in Chinese visa applicants. New developments relevant to the visa policy included the tightening of rules for the operation of the student visa scheme in respect of students from countries posing a migration risk. A new visa application centre was opened at the Consulate General in Dresden to serve as a visa application processing hub for our embassies and consulates in Europe.

In 2023, we received 171,000 visa applications (a 12 per cent increase year-on-year), including applications for short-stay Schengen visas (139,000), tourist visas (89,000), and working visas (19,000). There were 32,000 applications for long-stay visas and residence permits; the purpose of stay was either to work under the Employee Card scheme or to study (11,000 in each case). Visas were issued to 136,000 applicants (just under 80 per cent). The highest visa application intake was recorded at our consular sections in New Delhi, Riyadh, Astana, Istanbul, and Abu Dhabi.


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



Ministry in figures MFA staff









State budget allocation to the MFA

The Foreign Ministry carried on with its existing projects, especially the ones involving large investments into property abroad. We made great progress renovating the building of our Permanent Mission to the UN in New York. The project commenced in 2021 and we expect to complete it (including interior furnishings) in the first half of 2025. The renovated building will revert to residential use and will have a new extension to provide additional space.

The construction of a new embassy building in Canberra entered its final stages. We expect to complete this project (including interior furnishings) in the first half of 2024.

We completed the refurbishment of our building at Palace Gardens Terrace in London. The building will serve as the Czech Centre's gallery space.


Preparation for the refurbishment of the embassy building in Berlin entered a new stage. The architects, ATELIER ALFA, prepared the project documents and the Foreign Ministry applied for a construction permit. The construction permit process was set in motion.

In Czechia, an important project was to renovate and enlarge the Tuscany Palace's loft area and reroof the whole building. The project commenced in March 2023 and we expect to complete it (including interior furnishings) in the first half of 2024. The enlarged loft will serve as additional office space.


As part of our scheme to cut down energy costs, we installed energy-saving insulation on the top levels of the 1920's extension of the Czernin Palace (known as the "Janák Extension"). The insulation should prevent heat from escaping though the extension's flat roofs during the heating season and keep the interior temperature comfortable in the summer months.

An interesting project was the replacement of the two flagpoles on the Czernin Palace's balcony. The battered old flagpoles were replaced with new ones according to the original project.

Czechia finally recovered the title to its diplomatic properties in Warsaw, many years after losing it in connection with the



dissolution of the Czech and Slovak Federal Republic. Following a long series of negotiations, the matter was resolved by concluding a sale and purchase agreement. The purchase price was a symbolic PLN 1. The agreement was signed on 14 December 2022 at Poland's Foreign Ministry in Warsaw. Our title was registered with the land registry in June 2023 with effect from 14 December 2022.
