Categories of Art: drawing, painting, combined techniques (sculptures, metalworks, ceramics, wood, glass, textile, paper)

On top of tokens and certificates, the top winners will also receive cash prizes of up to five thousand pesos.

## Requirements

- The exhibition is open to children ages 10 to 14 years old.
- The maximum art format is 70 x 50 cm.
   Maximum of five (5) works of art per school or organization will be accepted.
- Only original copies of the artwork will be accepted.

  Artwork should be authenticated by the participant's art teacher or art mentor.

## Labeling of Entries

- Please follow the below template as tag for your entries. These tags should be placed at the bottom right portion of the back side of the artwork.
   Description on the tag must be legible, written in CAPITAL letters and in
- ROMÁN ALPHABET
- 3. Artwork should be authenticated by the participant's art teacher or art mentor.
  4. Courier fees will be shouldered by the participant.

- Closing date for the submission of entries: 30 June 2011 (Thursday)
- (Artwork received after the closing date will not be accepted.) July 2011: the expert panel of judges will inspect the artwork

Criteria for Judging Originality and Creativity Clarity of the Theme/ Relevance 30% Quality of Composition and Design 20% Overall Impact 10%

 End of July 2011: ceremonial opening of the exhibition and awarding of the winners of the competition at the Museo Pambata.

July to August 2011: Exhibition at the Museo Pambata

- 1. All artwork shall be submitted at the Embassy of the Czech Republic office, located at 30th Floor Rufino Pacific Tower, 6784 Ayala Avenue,
- Makati City 1200. Any artwork received after the closing date will not be accepted.

  2. Names of winners will be posted at the Embassy website (www.mzv.cz/manila). Each winner will be notified by the Czech Embassy through phone
- 3. Unawarded artwork can be returned by the end of 2011 upon the request of the participant at his own expense, unless otherwise specified.

The organizer reserves the right to use any of the received artwork for other non-commercial exhibitions, charitable events and for their reproduction in the press.
