Social Care Reform



- Transition from institutional to community-based services, supported the foundation of reforms and building institutional capacities
- Pilot centers, protected housing, and trained personnel support for people with mental disabilities
- New legal framework on continuous education of social workers, where 550 social workers trained and training modules developed

Support for Children with Autism



- Autism Law developed
- Specialized centers open and over 700 professionals trained
- Support for children with ASD and their families, including refugees

Home Care & Telemedicine



- · 12 medico-social centers
- Over 16.000 online consultations
- Support for the elderly, chronically ill, and refugees

Community Planning



- Participatory budgets implemented in 3 localities
- · 8 community initiatives funded
- · Local NGOs supported for sustainable service delivery
