Prague

The capital and largest city of the Czech Republic

- Population: 1.4 million
- Accounts for 27% of GDP
- Famous for architecture, museums, theaters, cinemas, galleries, and cafés
- Major Central European transport hub












Czechia: History Meets Mystery

Tourism

- 70,000 Canadians visited the Czech Republic in 2023
 - Springboard for travel to Germany, Austria, Poland, Hungary, etc.
- Direct Air Canada flights between Toronto and Prague
 - 3 flights/week from June to September

 100,000 Canadians claim Czech or Czechoslovak ancestry


Regions with largest diaspora:






Excellent Bilateral Relations

Over a century of diplomatic relations:

- 1920 Czechoslovak Consulate in Montreal
- 1942 Czechoslovak official envoy in Ottawa
- 1962 diplomatic relationship elevated to an ambassadorial level



Milestones:


- 1990, 1999 president Václav Havel in CA
- 2009 Czechia leads the EU to open CETA negotiations
- 2021 Canada Czechia Friendship Group
- 2024 Otto Jelinek received CZ Medal
- 2025 Group Chair John Brassard awarded the Medal for Distinguished Contribution to Diplomacy by Czech Foreign Minister

Foreign Trade

Dependence on international trade

- Exports equal 80% of GDP
- 80% of exports destined for the EU market

Largest Export Markets:

Germany, Poland and Slovakia

Largest Import Markets:

• Germany, Poland and China

Educated and Skilled Workforce

- Strong technological potential due to science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) workers
- Deep integration with the EU R&D ecosystem
 - Horizon Europe
- Youth Mobility Programme: Czech Republic & Canada
- Research cooperation between Czech & Canadian Universities
 - University of Waterloo & Technical University Liberec
 - McGill University & University of Economics in Prague



The University of Waterloo and CEITEC BUT (Central European Institute of Technology, Brno University of Technology) signing an MoU supporting cooperation in nanotechnology research, mobility, and other areas of common interest.






Total trade in goods (2024) = \$1.4 billion

- Critical minerals Canada-EU Strategic Partnership on Raw Materials
- Mining technologies, geological exploration, cleantech and remediation, hydrogen, nuclear, smart grids, research cooperation

Automotive, public transit & rail

- Electromobility, infrastructure for alternative fuels (electric, hydrogen fueling stations)
- Automotive technologies, development of autonomous and connected mobility (AI, cybersecurity)
- Public transport (electric & hydrogen buses)

 Supply of aerospace components and production cooperation, joint research

- Digital transformation in the public sector, workforce development, solutions for agriculture, healthcare and finance
- Collaboration across government and industry to address shared cyber threats

Agriculture and food industries

- Brewing technologies, drones/smart agriculture/agri-tech
- Joint R&D for new technologies/practices







Research, development, innovation and education

- Research collaboration, e.g. Horizon Europe
- Mobility opportunities for researchers and students (+ Youth Mobility)
- European research facilities in Czechia – superlasers EliBeamLines, BIOCEV
