The Janáček Trio consists of three outstanding soloists who have to their credit many performances in the Czech Republic and abroad, competition victories, recordings and collaborations with other important musicians and orchestras. The ensemble was founded in 2001 and since 2005 has been using Leoš Janáček's name with the permission of the Leoš Janáček Foundation.

The trio's repertoire includes works from stylistic periods ranging from the baroque era to music of the 21st century. A considerable part of its repertoire consists of music by Czech composers. The ensemble is also dedicated to premiering works by contemporary composers Jirí Gemrot, Ivo Bláha, Milan Slavický.
