## WHAT WILL BE THE IMPACT OF CONNECTING EUROPE FACILITY?

European Commission proposed a new infrastructure instrument "Connecting Europe Facility" (CEF) as well as a new proposal on TEN-T in October 2011. Its aim is to invest about 50 billion EUR into trans-European transport, energy and broadband networks. Majority of this allocation shall be used to co-finance modernisation of European transport infrastructure. Czech priority is to ensure the allocation for CEF will not endanger the overall budget of Cohesion Policy for 2014-2020 earmarked for new and less developed Member States. How will be the CEF budget redistributed? Is the European Commission attempting to gain more control at the account of Member States as regards infrastructure investments? Will CEF be the solution to ensuring connectivity of Europe for transport, energy and broadband?
