

Sining ČESko is a play on Filipino words 'Sining' (art) and 'ko' (I/me) and Czech word 'Česko' (Czech).

Literally translated as "My Czech Art," the contest is a unique opportunity for college and university students from the Philippines to discover the Czech Republic - the heart of Europe - while showcasing their talents in the visual arts by combining the use of common art media with indigenous Philippine materials.

CONTEST RULES

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Sining ČESko is open to college and university students age 16 to 21 years old.
- 2. Maximum dimensions for the artwork are 1 meter x 1 meter.
- **3.** Maximum of five (5) works of art per college/university will be accepted.
- **4.** Only original artwork will be accepted. Artwork should be authenticated by the participant's art teacher or art mentor as original.
- **5.** Any media or common art material may be used in creating your artwork: **pencil**, **colored pencil**, **charcoal**, **chalk**, **watercolor paint**, **acrylic paint**, **oil paint**, **etc**.
- 6 .The artwork must include the use of at least 1 indigenous Philippine material (coconut shell, bamboo, abaca, etc)

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Each artwork must be labeled at the bottom right portion of the back side of the artwork following the template below. It must be legible, written in CAPITAL letters and in ROMAN ALPHABET

- 1. The artwork must be authenticated and certified by the participant's art teacher or art mentor as an original and created solely by the participant.
- 2. The artwork may be hand-delivered or sent by courier. Courier fees will be shouldered by the participant.
- 3. Submission of entries will begin on 1 September 2011 (Thursday) at 10:00 am.
- 4. Closing date for the submission of entries is on 30 September 2011 (Friday) at 2:00pm

(Artwork received after the closing date will not be accepted.)

AWARDS & EXHIBITS

1. Judging, awarding ceremonies and exhibitions will be held in October 2011.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING:

Originality and Creativity - 40% Clarity of the Theme/Relevance - 30% Quality of Composition and Design - 20% Overall Impact - 10%



- 2. Ceremonial opening of the exhibit will be at SM Mall of Asia. Selected works of art, including the winners' work will be on display at the exhibit.
- **3.** Announcement of winners will be during the Czech Embassy's National Day celebration.
 - a. Top cash award: Php 10,000 pesos
 - **b.** Smaller cash awards for 2nd and 3rd place
 - c. Medals and/or trophies for the top winners
 - d. Certificates of Participation
 - e. Tokens

Names of winners will be posted on the Czech Embassy's official website on **www.mzv.cz/manila**.

Each winner will be notified by the Czech Embassy through phone or email.

4. Exact dates and specific venues to be announced at a later date.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Unawarded artwork may be returned by the end of March 2012 upon the request of the participant at his own expense, unless otherwise specified.
