- **The Faculty of Social Sciences (FSS)** is one of the newest faculties of Charles University in Prague
- Shortly after its creation in 1990 it became a regional centre of teaching and research in the key fields of social sciences
- FSS emphasizes the development of **foreign cooperation**. Firstly, by developing and strengthening scientific bonds, student and academic mobility and, secondly, by offering English language degree programmes

- Currently, the Faculty has around **4 000 full-time students**. Approximately **170** of them are enrolled in one of the **English language degree programmes**
- FSS has one of the **highest international mobility participation rates** of all the faculties of Charles University. Each year it welcomes around **500 exchange students** from all over the world
- Of course, one of the great attractions for international students is the location of the Faculty in **Prague**, the heart of the Czech Republic and whole Europe
