

Instructions for requesting Legalization of a Document Issued in the Czech Republic and attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Czech Republic

For documents issued by Czech authorities to be used in the UAE, they must be attested by legalisation process , known as superlegalisation.

After the document is attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Czech Republic, the next step is to be directly legalised by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the UAE (MOFA). This is best done via the MOFA App:




Step 1: MOFA app

Search for "MOFA UAE"




Step 2: Choose „Documents attestation“ service




Step 3: Confirm „start service“



Step 4: Check Attestation in the UAE



Step 5: Confirm that it is a new request



Step 6: Indicate that the documents were issued outside the UAE and select the country of origin

Step 7: Check that the document has been legalized by the relevant authority – the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Czech Republic

Finally, confirm and pay the fee.

Note – The web interface of the MOFA portal at this point incorrectly prompts for verification by the Czech Embassy.
