Ota Pavel, whose short stories are pictured in the film, was an author of biographical and autobiographical novels. The director Karel Kachyňa was particularly inspired by Ota Pavel's stories about a Czech-Jewish family in the pre-war and war period. Kachyňa put them together and created this beautiful film. The childhood of Ota Pavel is projected in a little boy called Prdelka. The plot takes place in a region close to the Czech river Berounka, where his dad and "uncle" Prošek teach him how to fish. Suddenly, tragic moments are about to happen, since the family has to face the German occupation. We will commemorate the anniversary of almost completed 85th birthday of Ota Pavel, which was on 31 March.
